Every Child within the age group of (6-14) will have to attend the school and we commit their retention and Quality education – this is the call of the day, the call of The Right of Children to Free & Compulsory Education (RCFCE) Act, 2009.

The Right of Children to Free & Compulsory Education Act, 2009 is a legislation passed by the Indian Parliament that has come into effect in our State from 1st April 2010. It is based on the 86th amendment in the Constitution through which an article 21(A) was inserted after Article 21 of the Constitution of India. The Act says that “The State shall provide free & compulsory education to all children of the age group of six to fourteen years by means of LAW”. Whereas, Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan is a historic stride towards achieving the long cherished goal of Universalisation of Elementary Education through a time bound integrated approach in the light of RTE. It promises to change the face of the Elementary Education of the Country within a specified time frame work. It aims to provide useful & quality in Elementary Education to all children in the age group of (6-14) years by 2010 with a strong, continuous and monitoring system. The National Curriculum Frame Work 2005 has strongly guided the need of substantial improvement in quality of education through upgrading the school and classroom environment, curriculum and Teaching Learning Material, School Management Committee and community support. Above all it is a people centered mode of implementation of educational interventions with involvement of stakeholders, especially teachers, parents, community, Panchayati Raj institutions and voluntary Organizations. RCFCE: Duties / Responsibilities of the State Govt:

- (i) To provide free & compulsory elementary education to all children in the age group 6-14 age group.
- (ii) To ensure availability of a neighbourhood school with requisite infrastructure, teachers and learning equipment as specified in the Act.
- (iii) To declare local authority in the State.
- (iv) To ensure admission, attendance & completion of elementary education for every child.
- (v) To ensure that children belonging to weaker section are not discriminated against and prevented from pursuing or completing elementary education on any ground.
- (vi) To provide Special Training facilities to out of school children admitted to age appropriate class.
- (vii) To provide training facilities to teachers as per RTE.
- (viii) To ensure timely prescribing of curriculum and course of studies.
- (ix) To ensure quality education conforming to standards specified in the schedule of the Act.
- (x) To ensure CCE instead of Annual Examination.

Achievements under Right to Education ACT:

In order to achieve the major goals under various components, efforts have been made to address the issues of enrolment, retention & achievement of all the children of the age group of (6-14) years. The achievements of SSA-RTE includes:-

- (i) Setting up of neighbourhood school concept i.e. 1 Km for Primary School & 3 Km for upper Primary School.
- (ii) Declaration of Local Authority.
- (iii) Appointment of teachers as per PTR in the context of RTE Act.
- (iv) Age appropriate admission of 6-14 age group children.
- (v) Special Training provision to the age appropriate admitted children.
- (vi) 25% Reservation in Private School for admission of children belonging weaker section and disadvantaged group.
- (vii) Implementation of no capitation fee and screening procedure for admission, no corporal punishment, no denial of admission
- (viii) Formation & implementation of School Management Committee (SMC).
- (ix) Implementation of Grievance Redressal Mechanism through Tollfree No i.e. 18003456722.
- (x) Implementation of SCPCR & formation of Core Committee on Shiksha Sambad at District & Block Level in the light of directions of NCPCR.
- (xi) Teacher's training, qualitative improvement of Elementary Education.
- (xii) Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE).
- (xiii) Provision of Teaching Learning Equipment and Teaching Learning Materials.
- (xiv) Establishment of Block & Cluster Resource Centres for academic support.
- (xv) Infrastructural facilities as per RTE Act.
- (xvi) Special provision for CWSN, Girls, SC, ST & Pre-school children.
- (xvii) Ensuring Teacher's accountability through SMC.
- (xviii) Adequate, rigorous, inclusive and continuous monitoring and Supervision.
- (XXi) 101 nos. of Upper Primary Schools have been provided with Computers

Functioning Structure of District Project Office, SSA:

District Project Office, RTE-SSA is Government of India flagship programme for achievement of Universalization of Elementary Education (UEE) in a time bound manner, as mandated by 86th amendment to the Constitution of India making free and compulsory Education to the Children of 6-14 years age group, a Fundamental Right.

In Odisha SSA has been implemented in 30 districts since 2001 with the following objectives –

1. All children of 6-14 years age group in school by 2003.
2. All children to complete 5 years of schooling by 2007.
3. All children to complete 8 years of schooling by 2010.
4. Universal retention by 2010.
5. Bridge all gender and social category gaps at primary stage by 2007 and at Upper Primary stage by 2010.
6. Focus on Elementary Education of satisfactory quality with focus on education for life.

Odisha Primary Education Programme Authority (OPEPA) came in to existence as a registered society on 30th January 1996. The School & Mass Education(S & ME) department in the Government of Odisha has the responsibility to achieve the goals of Universal Elementary Education (UEE). The S & M E Dept. operates through two agencies namely Directorate of Elementary Education (DEE) and Odisha Primary Education Programme Authority (OPEPA) to realize the goals of UEE. While DEE manages the entire manpower of teachers, inspectors & administrators, OPEPA implements the flagship program of SSA in the entire state.
