
Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA)

Keeping the above in view, the new Scheme titled '**Pradhan Mantri Digital Saksharta Abhiyan**' (PMGDISHA) aims to make six crore persons in rural areas across States/UTs digitally literate, reaching to around 40% of rural households by covering one member from every eligible household.

The Scheme would empower the citizens in rural areas by training them to operate computer or digital access devices (like tablets, smart phones etc.), send and receive e-mails, browse Internet, access Government services, search for information, undertake cashless transactions, etc. and hence enable them to use the Information Technology to actively participate in the process of nation building. The Scheme aims to bridge the digital divide, specifically targeting the rural population including the marginalised sections of society like Scheduled Castes (SC) / Scheduled Tribes (ST), Minorities, Below Poverty Line (BPL), women and differently-abled persons.

Project Objective

The objective of the programme is to make six crore persons in rural areas, across States/UTs, digitally literate, reaching to around 40% of rural households by covering one member from every eligible household. The IT literacy training has the following broad objectives:
