

## “Nanak Bageechi” established in Babe Nanaki Girls College

Kapurthala District Administration established third 'Nanak Bageechi' at Babe Nanaki Girls College, as part of the work dedicated to 550-year-old Prakash Purb of Shri Guru Nanak Dev Ji. This has been developed under the guidelines of Deputy Commissioner Er D.P.S Kharbanda. This third garden of the district, developed by the Department of Forest and Wildlife Protection, under the guidelines of Deputy Commissioner Shri D.P.S.Kharbanda and President, Jatinder Sharma. 550 different Plants beneficial to environment and human health are planted.

Launching the garden, Forestry Officer Jalandhar Mr. Rajesh Gulati said that the plants in this garden, developed according to Japanese technology 'Miyawaki', will grow many times faster and absorb carbon dioxide gases.
