ORDER:

In light of the order of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, issued vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2020, vide which "Intra and Inter-State movement of Harvesting and Sowing related machines like combined harvester and other agriculture/horticulture implements" has been added in the list of relaxations in the lockdown to maintain the supply chains.

Accordingly, in compliance of the "Consolidated Advisory Regarding Farm Operations (Harvesting, Marketing, Sowing, etc." issued by the Addl. Chief Secretary-cum-Financial Commissioner (Development), Government of Punjab, Chandigarh vide Endst. No. Agri.4/2020/SPL 1-28 dated 02.04.2020, the "Intra and Inter-State of Movement of Agriculture Machinery including tractors, trolleys, combine harvesters, other harvesting machinery and transport vehicles for carrying the farm produce, tilling and sowing implements, etc." is exempted from restrictions that came into effect vide the imposition of curfew in District Kapurthala by virtue of the order issued by this office vide Endst. No. 1251-1287/MA dated 23.03.2020 subject to the condition that the vehicle operators will ensure that the drivers, helpers, etc. shall necessarily follow the Health Advisories issued by the Govt. of India/Govt. of Punjab/other health authorities such as maintenance of social distancing and hygiene, use of face masks, gloves, sanitizers/hand-wash, etc. to prevent & control the outbreak of COVID-19.
