**ORDER:**

Whereas, in light of the instructions contained in letter No 7/56/2020/2H4/2143 dated 02.05.2021 issued by the Department of Home Affairs & Justice (Home-4 Branch), Government of Punjab, and in continuation of this office Orders issued vide Endst. No. 2836-2889/MA dated 01.05.2021; Endst. No. 2901-2954/MA dated 02.05.2021 and Endst. No. 2980-3033/MA dated 04.05.2021 I. Deepti Uppal, IAS, District Magistrate, Kapurthala, exercising the powers conferred under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr. PC), 1973, do, hereby, order that the Daily Curfew shall now be from 5.00PM to 5.00AM on all days and Weekend Curfew (from 5.00PM on Friday evening up to 5.00AM on Monday morning) throughout the territorial jurisdiction of District Kapurthala starting from 08.05.2021 till 15.05.2021.

Apart from the above, the following additional restrictions are, hereby, imposed in the District with effect from 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 till 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2021:

1. Nobody to enter in District Kapurthala whether by Air, Rail or Road without either:
  - (a). Negative Covid-19 Report not more than 72 hours old, or
  - (b). Vaccination Certificate (of at least one dose) over 2 weeks old.
2. Shops in the district will Open as per following schedule:

2	All other categories shops except those mentioned in S. No. 1	12Noon to 4PM	Monday to Friday
3	Medicine Shops of all categories (Wholesale/Retail), All kind of Medical/Health Activities, Petrol/Diesel Pumps	24X7	All Week Days

- Note:** (i). It is made clear that *Subzi & Fruit Mandis* in the district will be closed by 12Noon positively;  
(ii). No *Rehris* are allowed to park at any particular place and they should have to sell Fruits / *Subzi* by moving around the streets up to 4.00 PM.

3. Apart from above, all Construction Activities in Urban and Rural areas, and all Manufacturing / Industrial Units are allowed.
4. All Restaurants (including those in Hotels), Cafes, Coffee Shops, Fast Food Outlets, *Dhabas*, Sweet Shops, Bakeries, etc. to remain closed for Dine-In and may function ONLY FOR HOME DELIVERY till 8:00PM. NO seating is allowed inside Restaurants, Fast Food Joint, Coffee Shops, etc. to be allowed.
5. Guest can stay in hotels, but Hotel Authorities/Managements will ensure that the Guests must have either negative Covid-19 RT-PCR report not more than 72 hours old or Vaccination Certificates (of at least one dose) over 2 weeks old.
6. All Bars, Cinema Halls, Gyms, Spas, Swimming Pools, Coaching Centres, Sports Complexes, to remain closed.
7. All Paying Guests (PGs) to remain closed.

8. All Entertainments Parks/Parks to remain closed.
9. E-Commerce home delivery is allowed from 10.00AM to 4:00PM.
10. All Weekly Markets (such as *Apni Mandis*) to be closed.
11. There shall be a complete ban on all Social, Cultural or Sports gatherings, and related functions (including government functions, such as Inaugurations, Foundation-Stone Laying Ceremonies).
12. There shall be a complete ban across the district on all Political gatherings. For any gathering organized in violation of these orders, FIRs will be registered against the Organizers and Participants as well as against the Owners of the Venue and the Tent Houses under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897. Such venues shall also be sealed for future use.
13. Persons who have attended large gatherings anywhere (Religious/Political/Social) to be mandatorily Home Quarantined for five (05) days and tested as per protocol.
14. All Government Offices, Boards/Corporations as well as Banks will work at 50% strength other than those where officials are involved in Covid management. Identity Card of Govt./Board/Corporation/Bank Employees (On Duty) will act as Curfew Pass.
15. All Four-Wheeler Passenger vehicles, including Cars and taxis, not allowed to seat more than two (02) passengers. Vehicles carrying patients to Hospitals are exempted. No pillion riders on scooters and motorcycles except those belonging to the same family and living in the same house.
16. No gathering of more than ten (10) persons to be allowed, including for Weddings / Cremations / Funerals.
17. Villages will organize *Thikri Pehras* to ensure that 'Night Curfew' and 'Weekend Curfew' Orders are duly complied with.
18. Social Distancing to be maintained in *Subzi/Fruit Mandis*, which would be open only to Fruit and Vegetable Wholesalers. No retail-selling is allowed in wholesale *Subzi Mandi*. If anybody is found selling in retail in wholesale market, then license shall be cancelled by the District *Mandi* Officer.
19. Unions and Religious leaders not to hold gatherings and restrict number of protesters to token presence at Toll Plazas Pumps, Malls, etc.
20. Strict action will be taken against those hoarding Oxygen Cylinders, etc.
21. RT-PCR testing of Road and Street vendors, such as *Rehriwallas* etc. to be carried out. Traffic police and Medical Teams to coordinate to ensure that intensive testing is carried out.
22. Number in Public Transport (Buses, Taxis, Autos) to be restricted to 50% of the capacity. Transport and Civil Officials, along with Police Personnel, to constitute Flying Squads to enforce.
23. All Educational Institutions i.e. School and Colleges to remain Closed.
24. All the Medical and Nursing Colleges may continue to remain Open.
25. All Recruitment Exams to be Postponed, unless it relates to recruitment of Covid-19 management-related manpower.

26. All Private Offices, including Service Industry, such as offices of Architects, Chartered Accountants (CAs), Insurance Companies etc. allowed to 'Work from Home' only.
27. In Government offices - Health/ Frontline Workers and employees over 45 years who have not got at least one vaccine dose in last 15 days or more, should be encouraged to take leave and stay home until then. Employees under 45 years to be allowed only on basis of negative RT-PCR not more than 5 days old or else should take leave and stay home.
28. Micro containment Zones in High Positivity areas to be increased and strictly enforced. Special Monitors to be designated for enforcement.
29. Grievance Redressal by all the government offices shall be preferred through virtual/ on-line modes. Public dealings be discouraged as far as possible and allowed only when deemed unavoidable. Revenue Department shall also endeavor to limit appointments to public to bare minimum for execution of conveyance deeds for sale and purchase of properties.


All the extant directives of the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), Government of India; Government of Punjab & District Administration, Kapurthala on COVID-appropriate behaviour including Social Distancing norm of maintaining minimum six (06) feet distance (*Do Gaz Ki Doori*), regulating crowds in marketplaces and public transport, and imposition of penalties prescribed for violation of COVID-appropriate behaviour like wearing of face masks, etc. shall be strictly enforced.

This Order shall be applicable with effect from 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 till 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2021.

Any violation of this Order shall be punishable under Sections 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC), 1860.
