**ORDER:**

This is in continuation of the detailed directions regarding COVID-19 related restrictions issued by this office vide Order bearing Endst. No. 4440–4493/MA dated 15.06.2021, which is valid from 16<sup>th</sup> June to 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.

Further that representations have been received from the Kapurthala Association of Travel & Educational Consultants (KATEC), Kapurthala and the IELTS Association, Bholath recently that since the COVID-19 cases in the State of Punjab as well as District Kapurthala have dropped sharply, and while most of the other business/commercial establishments, including non-essential ones, have been allowed to open from 8AM to 7PM from Monday to Saturday, the restrictions on the Opening/Functioning of Travel Agents/Educational Consultants/IELTS Centres, etc. in District Kapurthala have not been relaxed. It has also been mentioned in their representations that they tried to give online coaching to students but due to data/network & electricity-related issues primarily in the rural areas, the students are unable to study online. They have further brought to notice that IELTS exams of many students, who had booked their test before the lockdown restrictions came into force, are calling them every day. They have requested that permission may kindly be granted to Open their Institutes/Centres so that they could resume their functioning/operations so as to help these students as their future and examination fee is at stake.

Keeping in view the above-mentioned representations and in furtherance of the earlier Order of the undersigned referred to above, which was issued vide Endst. No.4440–4493/MA dated 15.06.2021, and taking into account the present COVID-19 situation in District Kapurthala, I, Deepti Uppal, IAS, District Magistrate, Kapurthala, exercising the powers conferred under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr. PC), 1973, do, hereby, order to amend sub-para no. (ii) of Para I titled, “Restrictions” of the above-said Order dated 15.06.2021 as under:

“(ii). All Restaurants (including in Hotels), Cafes, Coffee Shops, Fast-Food Outlets, *Dhabas*, etc., Cinemas, Gyms, Museums & other Institutions/Centres to be opened at maximum 50% capacity, subject to all their employees having received at least one (01) dose of vaccination, and also subject to their adhering to COVID-19 appropriate behaviour including Social Distancing norm of minimum six (06) feet distance [*Do Gaz ki Doori*] and various SOPs/Guideines issued by the Govt. of India, Govt. of Punjab, District Administration, Kapurthala and other statutory agencies from time to time.

Shops & other commercial establishments viz. Restaurants (including in Hotels), Cafes, Coffee Shops, Fast-Food Outlets, *Dhabas*, other Institutions/Centres, etc., in District Kapurthala will Open as per following Schedule:

- Note:** (i). *While the Restaurants (including in Hotels), Cafes, Coffee Shops, Fast-Food Outlets, Dhabas, etc shall close by 7PM from Monday to Saturday, the Home Delivery can be done till 10PM*
- (ii). *All Educational Institutions i.e. Schools & Colleges to remain CLOSED.*

All other Restrictions & Exemptions issued vide the above-mentioned issued vide Endst. No.4440-4493/MA dated 15.06.2021 remain the same.

This Order shall be applicable within the territorial jurisdiction of District Kapurthala with immediate effect till 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2021.

Any violation of this Order shall be punishable under Sections 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC), 1860.
