In continuation of Order No.546-846/COVID/2020 dated 04.04.2020 and Order No.847-1250/COVID/2020 dated 06.04.2020 wherein Haryana Government using the power conferred under section 2 of the Epidemic Disease Act, 1897 and regulation made thereof, all the Commissioners of Municipal Corporation or Executive Officers Municipal Councils and all Secretaries of Municipal Committees were authorized to dispose of dead bodies of COVID as per the guidelines/protocol on Dead Body Management. Now, for rural areas, all concerned BDPOs hereby authorize to dispose of dead bodies of COVID strictly as per laid down procedure in above said orders. The roles and responsibility of BDPOs are similar to Commissioners/EOs/Secretaries of Urban Local Bodies. The Order No.546-846/COVID/2020 dated 04.04.2020 and Order No.847-1250/COVID/2020 dated 06.04.2020 are applicable mutatis mutandis to rural areas also.
