

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, under the directions passed by National Disaster Management Authority under section 6(2)(i) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Union Home Secretary, being the Chairman, National Executive Council (NEC), in exercise of the powers conferred under section 10(2)(i) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, has issued order vide No. 40-3/2020-DM-1(A) dated 29th June, 2020 to re-open more activities in a calibrated manner (Unlock-2), in areas outside the Containment Zones and to extend the lockdown in the Containment Zones upto 31.07.2020 and issued new guidelines as annexed therewith for strict implementation.

AND whereas under Clause 2 of the new guidelines for Phased Re-opening (Unlock-2), it has been specified that movement of individuals shall remain strictly prohibited between 10.00 PM to 05.00 AM throughout the country, except for essential activities, including operation of industrial units in multiple shifts, movement of persons and goods on National and State Highways, loading and unloading of cargo and travel of persons to their destinations after disembarking from buses, trains and airplanes during this period to ensure well being and safety of persons.

Now, I am satisfied that the directions are necessary, in compliance with the aforementioned orders, to strictly prohibit the movement of individuals, except for essential activities, including operation of industrial units in multiple shifts, movement of persons and goods on National and State Highways, loading and unloading of cargo and travel of persons to their destinations after disembarking from buses, trains and airplanes between 10.00 PM to 05.00 AM in the interest of maintenance of public health, hygiene and safety in view of COVID-19 epidemic.

Therefore, I, Ramesh Chander Bidhan, IAS, District Magistrate, Sirsa, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, do hereby strictly prohibit the movement of individuals between 10.00 PM to 05.00 AM throughout the district, except for essential activities, including operation of industrial units in multiple shifts, movement of persons and goods on National and State Highways, loading and unloading of cargo and travel of persons to their destinations after disembarking from buses, trains and airplanes as well as outward movement with immediate effect till 31.07.2020.

The order shall be publicized for the information of general public and promulgated within the revenue limits of district Sirsa through publicity van of Public Relations Department and also by affixing copies of this order at District, Sub Divisional, Tehsil Courts, Police Stations and other public places as well.

The compliance of this order shall be strictly enforced and ensured by all Executive Magistrates/Police Officials on duty and any violation of the same shall be strictly dealt with as per Sections 188, 269 and 270 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
