

## ORDER

Consequent upon detection/reporting of Corona Positive Cases in different parts of the territorial jurisdiction of districts Sirsa from various Viral Research and Diagnostic Laboratories (VRDL) by RT-PCR/Rapid Antigen Testing, Containment Zones and Buffer zones are demarcated from time to time to prevent spread of COVID-19 in the adjoining areas and action plan as provided under the protocol, active search for cases through physical house to house surveillance; testing of all suspect cases as per sampling guidelines; contact tracing; strict enforcement of social distancing; clinical management of all confirmed cases; quarantine; isolation and other public health measures in the Containment Zones and passive search in Buffer Zone is also being carried out by the Health Authorities. After accomplishment of the surveillance operations in the Containment Zones/Buffer Zones are being scaled-down as per the protocol.

Now, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (Directorate General of Health Services-Government of India) has issued a Office Memorandum vide F.No.Z.28015/30/2020-EMR dated 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 prescribing the following guidelines for Scaling Down the Surveillance Operations; De-notification of the Containment Zones:

***"In view of the hardships faced by residents, States having such Containment Zones with prolonged lockdowns, may opt for the following :***

- i) ***The surveillance operations will be scaled down if no laboratory confirmed COVID-19 case is reported from the Containment Zone for at-least 14 days after the last confirmed case has been isolated and all the contacts of the confirmed case have been followed up for 14 days.***
- ii) ***De-notification of the Containment Zone will be done 14 days after discharge of last confirmed case (instead of 28 days)***
- iii) ***However, the surveillance for I.L.I./S.A.R.I. and their rigorous testing will continue in the de-notified Containment and Buffer Zones. If further positive cases emerge in the de-notified Containment or Buffer Zone, the area will again be declared as Containment Zone and the containment process shall begin afresh.***
- iv) ***The City/District/State will be declared free from the disease outbreak only after 28 days have passed since the last confirmed case has tested negative by RT-PCR.***

Keeping in view the above guidelines/instructions; Civil Surgeon, Sirsa vide his office letters No. IDSP/20/3813 and 3826 dated 16.09.2020 has suggested to scale-down surveillance operations/containment activities in three Containment Zones namely (i) Gali No. 2, Telian Wali Gali, Sirsa (ii) Chopra Wali Gali, Near Multani Dharamshala, Sirsa and (iii) Gali No. 8, Backside Shree Hanuman Mandir, Aggarsein Colony, Sirsa, as per guidelines referred at (i) above.

Hence, as proposed and suggested by Civil Surgeon, Sirsa, it is hereby ordered to scale-down the on-going surveillance operations/containment activities in respect of three Containment Zones namely (i) Gali No. 2, Telian Wali Gali, Sirsa (ii) Chopra Wali Gali, Near Multani Dharamshala, Sirsa and (iii) Gali No. 8, Backside Shree Hanuman Mandir, Aggarsein Colony, Sirsa w.e.f. 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 i.e. after completing 14 days period with further directions to Civil Surgeon, Sirsa to carry out passive reporting of ILI/SARI cases accordingly in the Containment Zone being/likely to be scaled down.


In reference to subject cited above, it is to bring into your kind notice that last COVID positive case were reported as following from following areas.

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
