



In this highly competitive world where computers are the New Gods, it has become crucial to get hands-on with these machines. Technology has altered the way we think and imagine. While West Singhbhum lacked both resources and proper guidance in this field, the District Administration came up with a highly innovative and beneficial program called the District e-Governance Society (DeGS) Computer Training program, to battle this problem. The DeGS was started with the idea to provide an opportunity for the underprivileged to become tech-savvy and job-ready. The program included an extensive course of 60 days consisting of 32 modules that covered all the basics of computers and more.



It is a gratuitous initiative in which training being delivered in district collectorate by development associates who were inducted from countries topmost institutes like IIT/NIT/BIT etc.

The ever-increasing number of enthusiastic students is a testament to the wide acceptance of DeGS among the people of West Singhbhum. The current course design comprises of 3 classrooms, 60 computers, 24 classes per day with 30 students in each batch. The idea is to accommodate and train more and more students whilst never compromising on the quality of the training. Program is run in the meagre budget of 1

lakh, without imposing an extra burden on the government for expenditure. About 1700 students have already been benefited by this programme and the aim is to make it reach each and every household of West Singhbhum so that no one here feels left behind and can very confidently go digital !!
