



Fight Against COVID-19

ORDER

Whereas, the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic is posing a threat to public health, the Government of Haryana has taken necessary steps to prevent its spread in the state of Haryana.

Whereas, in exercise of the powers under the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chairperson, State Executive Committee has authorized the Deputy Commissioners in the State to take necessary decision regarding closing of shops in such crowded areas of their districts as they deem fit after 6:00 p.m. and opening of restaurants/eating places only for home delivery with immediate effect. Deputy Commissioners were also advised to ensure that sufficient numbers of drug/pharmaceutical shops and Grocer stores may be allowed to remain open after 6:00 p.m. in the crowded markets, as is considered necessary, so as to avoid any inconvenience to citizens.

Whereas, in exercise of powers vested under Disaster Management Act, 2005, I, Ajay Kumar, IAS, District Magistrate, Mahendragarh at Narnaul in my capacity as Chairman, DDMA, Mahendragarh hereby order that:

1. All the shops and malls within the limits of District Mahendragarh shall be closed after 6:00 p.m.
2. Restaurants/eating places within the limits of district Mahendragarh shall open only for home delivery/ take away.

However drug/pharmaceutical shops, grocery stores and petrol pumps are allowed to remain open after 6:00 p.m.

Any person violating these orders shall be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions applicable.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect from 23.04.2021 and shall remain in force till further orders.

In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated by affixing copies thereof on the notice boards of the office of the Deputy Commissioner as well as District Courts, Sub Divisions, Tehsils and other government offices and publication in the newspapers having circulation in the area, through the office of the DIPRO, Narnaul. This order shall also be uploaded on the official website of the district and official social media accounts.
