ORDER

Whereas on **the occasion of festival of Diwali** there is an apprehension of danger to health and safety to human life particularly to the persons with co-morbidity, old age persons, infant, children, patient of respiratory disorder and the patients of Covid-19 and mortality due to COVID-19 Pandemic. The air quality index of District Panipat is already poor due to air pollution and during the festival of Diwali the bursting of crackers in District Panipat is likely to make AQI more poor which will cause irreparable loss and hazard to the health, safety and human life and would affect more adversely COVID-19 patients who are already prone to the respiratory diseases, COVID-19 being respiratory disorder.

And whereas considering all these exigencies I am of the opinion that the sale and use of all type of fire crackers should be banned in the territorial limits of District Panipat.

Therefore, I Dharmender Singh, IAS District Magistrate, Panipat in exercise of powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 Cr, P.C, 1973 and the explosive act 1884/Rules 2008 and other enabling powers to me as District Magistrate, Panipat, do, hereby, prohibit the use of any type of crackers/explosives in the territorial limits of District Panipat.

If any person violates this order, then penal action under the relevant section of IPC and the Explosive Act, 1884 and Explosive Rules, 2008 shall be taken against him/her.

These orders shall come into force with immediate effect and remain in force up to 30/11/2020

The Superintendent of Police, Panipat, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Panipat, CMC Panipat, all Sub Divisional Magistrates, City Magistrate, Panipat, DDPO, Panipat, all Tehsildars /Naib Tehsildars, R O, PCB Panipat, DSPs, BDPOs, EO/Secy. Municipal Councils/Committees, SHOs of all police stations, Fire Office and other fire department staff of district Panipat shall ensure the compliance of this order. All officers are directed to conduct raids, alongwith SHO concerned, wherever necessary and initiate penal action as warranted.

The District Public Relation Officer, Panipat shall give wide publicity to this order throughout the District Panipat and this order should also be sent to press for wide publicity. DIO/ADIO is directed to post the order on official website.

It is not possible to serve this notice to the public at large individually, so in view of emergent situation, this order is passed ex-parte and is addressed to public at large.
