ORDER

Whereas, it has come to the notice of the undersigned by Regional Officer, Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Panipat that illegal discharge of domestic and industrial effluent into the Drain No.2 is being done by the tankers. Further, Drain No.2 and Panipat Drain leads to the River Yamuna, hence causing contamination into River Yamuna. Due to discharge of untreated domestic and industrial effluent, there is an apprehension of danger to health of the public, animals and other living creatures.

And whereas, considering the exigencies apprehended, the illegal discharge of domestic/industrial effluent into drain should be banned in the territories limit of District Panipat.

Now, Therefore, I, **Dharmender Singh, IAS, District Magistrate, Panipat-cum-Chairman, Special Environment Surveillance Task Force of District Panipat**, in the exercise of powers vested in me by virtue section 144 Cr, P. C, 1973, do hereby prohibit any type of discharge into drains through tankers in the territorial limits of District Panipat. If any person violates this order, then penal action under the relevant section of IPC shall be taken against him/her.


This order shall come into force with immediate effect and remains in force till further orders.

The Superintendent of Police, Panipat, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Panipat, Executive Engineer, Irrigation and Water Resource Department, Panipat, Executive Engineers, PHED, Panipat, RO PCB, Panipat, District Development & Panchayat Officer, Panipat, All BDPOs, Secretary, Municipal Committee, Samalkha shall ensure the compliance of this order. All officers are directed to conduct raids alongwith SHO concerned whenever necessary and initiate penal action as warranted.

The District Public Relation Officer, Panipat shall give wide publicity to this order throughout the District Panipat and this order should also be sent to press for wide publicity. District DIO/ADIO is directed to post the order on official website. It is not possible to serve this notice to the public at large individually, so in view of emergent situation this order is passed ex-parte and is addressed to public at large.


