ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 CrPC

No.NDC.6/2001/Pt.I/18/170,

Dated, Nongstoin, the 4 th June, 2021

WHEREAS, in view of high transmissibility of this particular variant of the virus, it is deemed necessary to take urgent measures to prevent further spread of the COVID-19 virus, to avoid an overwhelming strain on the health system and to avoid the loss of precious lives,

Whereas, more exhaustive steps are required to be undertaken to effectively contain the virus through proper tracing and isolation of positive persons including returnees, to mobilize all resources and community support for vaccination which is the only way to protect the population at large, to build capacity on all fronts including confidence on home care & home management of mild cases and to impart proper awareness on preventive aspects of the disease for which the Health Department has a critical window period,

Therefore, I Shri T. Lyngwa IAS, District Magistrate, West Khasi Hills District, in exercise of the power conferred upon me under Section 144 Cr.P.C read with Regulation 3 of the Meghalaya Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 do hereby promulgate LOCKDOWN in West Khasi Hills District with effect from 5:00 AM of 7 th June, 2021 till 5:00 AM of 14 th June, 2021.

1. No vehicular movement is permitted except for essential services including Health Services.
2. Inter- district movement of persons from and to West Khasi Hills District shall continue to be restricted.
3. All major markets in West Khasi Hills District shall remain closed.
4. Political, public, social and religious gathering are not permitted including conferences, meetings and trainings.
5. Inter-State movement of persons shall continue to be restricted, with certain exemptions.
6. Movement of Vehicles both Private and Commercial during Lockdown are not allowed without obtaining permission from the authority.
7. Ecommerce, home delivery, hardware stores and courier services are permitted only after obtaining permission from the Undersigned.
8. In-situ construction works for Government Projects that does not involve movement of labour are permitted only after obtaining permission from the Undersigned.
9. Non –essential economic activities are permitted on need basis only after obtaining permission from the Undersigned.
10. Funeral gatherings are restricted to 10 persons with prior permission from the Undersigned.
11. Weddings and Sports activities are not permitted.

This Order will NOT apply to:-

1. Medical Team on duty/ Health services including Vaccination drive.
2. Essential services including Health Services, Food Corporation of India, Fire and Emergencies Services.
3. Movement of essential goods.
4. Press, Print and Electronic Media
5. Farming activities in rural areas including betel nut and betel leaf.
6. MGNREGA activities in rural areas.
7. Banks and Post Offices are permitted to open with limited staff.
8. Officers and staff of Corona Care Centre.
9. All officials on COVID-19 Duty.
10. Pharmacies, Police, Civil defence and Home Guards.
11. Petrol Pumps , Electricity, Water Supply, Public distribution system.



12. LPG Deliveries, Telecommunication services
13. NARI/1917i Teams
14. Public Works Department (PWD).
15. Public Health Department (PHE).
16. Activities / services permitted by competent authority.
17. Solid Liquid Resource Management Volunteers.

However, Funeral gathering to be restricted to 10 persons with prior permission from the Undersigned and strict adherence to SOPs and Health Advisories.

For water tankers specific permission is to be obtained from this Office.

The above mentioned services shall strictly comply with all protocols and SOPs including social distancing, proper wearing of mask, limiting of field staff to the barest minimum and other advisories

of Government in the Health and Family Welfare Department WITHOUT FAIL.

Also, movement of vehicles carrying Essential good, Security Forces, Medical Equipment's and shops for repairs of trucks on highways are exempted. However drivers and attendants of the vehicles shall be subjected to medical screening as per laid down protocols.

Essential commodities will be made available through shops in the localities as per the arrangement made by the village under the Supervision of the Incident Commander. Citizens are instructed to restrict themselves within their respective localities.

This order is in partial modification of this Office Order No.NDC.6/2001/Pt.I/18/169 dt. 3/06/2021,

With a view to enable the general public to procure their essential requirements the Curfew for the 5th June, 2021 and the 6th June, 2021 is hereby relaxed from 11.00 AM to 4.00 PM

In view of the urgency of the matter this order has been made ex-parte.
