

Comprehensive School Infrastructure Development Scheme (CSIDS)

One of the ten core themes of the Hon'ble Chief Minister's Vision Tamil Nadu 2023 aims to provide best infrastructure services in India in terms of Universal access to Water and Sanitation.

Comprehensive School Infrastructure Development Scheme (CSIDS) was launched during 2011-2012 with an objective of providing basic infrastructure facilities like **new buildings, kitchen sheds, water supply, toilets, etc.** in the Panchayat Union Primary and Middle Schools in rural areas.

Repairs and renovation of the existing facilities will also be taken up wherever necessary.

Selection of Schools :

The basic aim of the Scheme is to provide all basic infrastructure facilities like construction of New School Buildings, Kitchen Sheds, Toilets and Water Supply facilities and the repair and renovation of School Buildings, Kitchen Sheds, Toilets and Water Supply facilities in the Panchayat Union Primary and Middle Schools in Rural areas.

This Programme will be implemented in those Panchayat Union Schools located in the Village Panchayats selected under "**Tamil Nadu Village Habitations Improvement (THAI)**" Scheme.

Likewise, all types of facilities shall be taken up in those Panchayat Union Schools located in Town Panchayat and Municipalities. **The following**

i). School Buildings

a). New Buildings

New building for the school shall be constructed on the basis of the students strength (Approximately 9 sq.feet per student).

If adequate space is not available, the building can be constructed on the first floor of the existing RCC building after confirming the structural stability.

b). Repairs to the existing school building

White wash / colour washing of the buildings

Undertaking repairs of RCC roof.

Repairs / replacement of damaged flooring.

Painting of Black Boards.

Repair / replacement of doors and windows.

Minor repairs of damaged tiles / rafters / reapers in buildings with tiled roofing.

Repairs of cracks in building walls.



ii). Kitchen Shed

In those schools where



Kitchen sheds are not available, new kitchen sheds can be taken up.

Existing kitchen shed building which are in damaged condition, can be repaired and renovated.

Additional rooms / store rooms may be constructed for storage of materials of Noom MealCentre.

iii). Water supply facilities.

If the existing water supply system is damaged, repairs can be carried out.

Extension of pipe line works may be taken up.

New water supply connection may be provided.

Wherever necessary new borewell (hand pump fitted) can also be taken up.

iv). Toilets

Repairs and renovation of the existing toilets.

Wherever required, sanitary tiles may be fixed.

Incinerators should be provided in the girls toilet.

Water supply should be provided in the toilets

White washing and colour washing of the toilets.

Construction of new toilets shall be taken up based on the strength of students.



v). Compound walls

Based on the necessity and fund availability, the construction of compound walls for the schools shall also be taken up.
