# WOMEN EMPOWERMENT THROUGH SHGs



- 900 women SHGs/ 9000 families gainfully employed
- 150 women SHGs/ 1600 women plugging public transport gap in rural hinterland through e-autos – Rs. 275 lakhs from DMF for initial subsidy towards e – rickshaws

- 151 women SHGs earning more than Rs. 4.5 lac per farm through exotic kadaknath backyard poultry farming - Rs. 942 lakhs from DMF for shed constructions

- 250 women SHGs/ 3000 families are taking agro-processing to village clusters – earning approx. Rs. 1.5 cr. per month – reducing post harvest losses – Rs. 231 lakh from DMF for subsidy towards rice mills
- 450 boxes deployed for apiculture – annual increase in income of Rs. 45,000 per family – Rs. 50 lakh from DMF for training of farmers & SHGs, and honey boxes

- 45 days on – job training of youth by Livelihood College, Dantewada under MMKVY, presently 550 youth being trained
- Computer literate youth from remote parts of Dantewada, Sukma and Bijapur working in the BPO
