

ORDER


Whereas, curfew has been imposed in the District to contain the spread of COVID-19 epidemic vide Order No. CBA-Peshi-M-43(23)/2019-171 dated 24th March, 2020.

Whereas, due to this a number of migrant labours are now left in the District without any earning mechanism. At the same time resident of this District working in other state have also moved back to the District in large number.

Therefore, to deal with the aforementioned situation & mitigate the economic hardships of migrant workers and to contain the spread of COVID-19 due to immigration from outside the District the following orders are issued under the section 3 of National Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Regulation 3 of the HP Epidemic Disease (COVID-19) Regulations, 2020.

- i. That all adequate arrangements including temporary shelters, and provision of food etc., for the poor and needy people, including migrants labourers, stranded due to the enforcement of the curfew in their respective jurisdiction shall be made.
- ii. That the all persons entering the District on & after 28th March, 2020 from outside the State shall be kept in the nearest shelters and quarantine facilities after proper screening for a minimum period of 14 days as per standard health protocol.
- iii. It should be ensured that all the employers, shall make payments of wages of their workers working in the industry or in the shops and commercial establishments, at their work places, on the due date, without any deduction, for the period their establishments are under closure during the lockdown.
- iv. Wherever the workers, including the migrants are living in the rented accommodation, landlords of those properties shall not demand payment of rent for a period of one month. If any landlord is forcing labourers and students to vacate their premises, they will be liable for action under the Act.


It is directed that the SDMs and Head of Departments in the District shall take all measures necessary for the implementation of above direction. Further, the HoDs shall be personally liable if any contractor under their purview derelicts his duties & responsibilities as imposed by this order.
