ORDER

Whereas, the Chairman State Executive Committee (SEC) cum Chief Secretary to the Government of HP after a careful review of the recent spike in COVID-19 vide Order No. Rev (DMC) (C) 20-02/2021-COVID-19-III dated 3rd and 6th April 2021 (**Copies enclosed**) has issued additional directions to contain and arrest the spread of COVID-19;

Now, therefore, I, D C Rana (IAS), District Magistrate, Chamba in exercise of the powers vested in me under Section 34 of the Disaster Management Act 2005, and in compliance of the above said Order of SEC and in continuance of this office order of even no. dated 26.03.2021, do hereby, order that the following directions for Surveillance, Containment and Caution shall be strictly implemented by all the Magistrate, Police Officers, Officers of the Local Authorities and other Departments to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the District Chamba with: -


1. All educational institutions schools/colleges/universities/institutions will remain closed upto 15.04.2021. All teaching/non-teaching staff will however continue to attend their respective institutions. Students of the classes having their scheduled examinations in the near future can visit the school/educational institute to clear any doubts with written consent of the parents/guardian. All coaching centres to prepare for competitive exams and nursing/medical/dental colleges will remain open and ensure observance of the COVID-19 SOPs issued by Government from time to time. Schools/Institutions having residential facilities need not close their hostel facilities but must observe SOPs issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India for Covid-19 prevention and COVID-19 appropriate behaviour. The educational institutions that are earmarked as examination centres shall be properly sanitized prior to being used as examination centers. All such schools/educational institutions also must appoint a compliance officer for this purpose

2. In open spaces/grounds, in areas outside the Containment Zones, keeping the size of the ground/space in view, number of persons allowed will be 50% of the capacity subject to **maximum of 200 persons** and with strict observance of social distancing, mandatory wearing of face covers/masks, provision of thermal scanning and hand wash or sanitizer.
3. In closed spaces, in areas outside the Containment Zones, number of persons allowed shall be 50 % of the hall capacity subject to **maximum of 50 persons**. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizer will be mandatory in all such venues.
4. Organizers shall be responsible to ensure compliance of these conditions & other SOPs issued, failing which they will be liable to prosecuted or fine shall be imposed upon them.
5. Sub Divisional Magistrates & Deputy Superintendents of Police along with PRIs and ULBs shall monitor the compliance of these orders in all events being held in their jurisdiction. Further organisers of all such events shall compulsorily seek permission through [https:// covid.hp.gov.in/](https://covid.hp.gov.in/) in portal.

Any person violating these measures/directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Sections 51-60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 besides legal action under section 111,114 & 115 of HP Police Act, 2007 and section 188 of IPC, and other legal provision as applicable.

This order shall come into enforce with immediate effect and shall remain valid, till further orders.

ORDER

Whereas an Order dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure A) was issued to arrest the spread of COVID-19 in the State for compliance with order and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India for containment of COVID-19 dated 23.03.2021.

And whereas, after a careful review of the recent spike in COVID-19 cases it is evident that it still remains a public health risk and caution is necessary for the containment of spread of COVID-19 in the State.

Now, therefore after considering the current situation of the COVID-19 pandemic and the overall circumstances, in exercise of the powers conferred under the Section 24 (e) of the DM Act 2005, the undersigned in the capacity of the Chairman, State Executive Committee (SEC), hereby orders that the existing orders of SEC dated 26.03.2021 for management of COVID-19 will be strictly enforced subject to following modification:

1. All educational institutions schools/colleges/universities/institutions will remain closed upto 15.04.2021. All teaching/non-teaching staff will however continue to attend their respective institutions. Students of the classes having their scheduled examinations in the near future can visit the school/educational institute to clear any doubts with a written consent of the parents/guardian. All coaching centres to prepare for competitive exams and nursing/medical/dental colleges will remain open and ensure observance of the COVID-19 SOPs issued by Government from time to time. Schools/Institutions having residential facilities need not close their hostel facilities but must observe SOPs issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India for Covid-19 prevention and COVID-19 appropriate behaviour. The educational institutions that are earmarked as examination centres shall be properly sanitized prior to being used as examination centers. All such schools/educational institutions also must appoint a compliance officer for this purpose.

All the Departments and Organisations of the Government, District Magistrates, Police Officers/Officials and Local Authorities of the State are directed to ensure strict compliance with the directions of the SEC and various SOPs *ibid*.

This Order shall remain in force, in all parts of the State with immediate effect till further orders.



ORDER

Whereas Orders dated 25.03.2021, 26.03.2021 & 03.04.2021 were issued to arrest the spread of COVID-19 in the State for compliance with order and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India for containment of COVID-19 dated 23.03.2021.

And whereas, after a careful review of the recent spike in COVID-19 cases it is evident that it still remains a public health risk and caution is necessary for the containment of spread of COVID-19 in the State.

Now, therefore after considering the current situation of the COVID-19 pandemic and the overall circumstances, in exercise of the powers conferred under the Section 24 (e) of the DM Act 2005, the undersigned in the capacity of the Chairman, State Executive Committee (SEC), hereby orders that the existing orders of SEC for management of COVID-19 will be strictly enforced subject to following directions:

In social/ academic/ sports/ entertainment/ cultural/ religious/ political gatherings and other congregations, limit of number persons will be as under:-

- *In open spaces/grounds, in areas outside the Containment Zones, keeping the size of the ground/space in view, number of persons allowed will be 50% of the capacity subject to maximum of 200 persons and with strict observance of social distancing, mandatory wearing of face covers/masks, provision of thermal scanning and hand wash or sanitizer.*
- *In closed spaces, in areas outside the Containment Zones, number of persons allowed shall be 50% of the hall capacity subject to maximum of 50 persons. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizer will be mandatory in all such venues.*
- *Organizers shall be responsible to ensure compliance of these conditions & other SOPs issued, failing which they will be liable to be prosecuted or fine shall be imposed upon them.*

The respective District Magistrates/Superintendents of Police will take adequate measures to implement these orders with the support of all the PRIs and ULBs in letter and spirit. This Order shall remain in force, in all parts of the State with immediate effect till further orders.
