Subject: - Regarding issue of necessary instructions to make available the services of Hospitals as Dedicated Covid Hospitals.


Sir,

In this context, it is requested to kindly comply with the directions issued in letter attached and take appropriate action into the matter accordingly please.



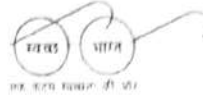

Dear Secretary,

Please refer to Health Secretary's D.O. letter No. 7(23)/2020-NHM-I, dated 16th April, 2021 regarding issue of necessary instructions to make available the services of hospitals under the control of your Departments/ PSUs as dedicated Covid hospitals, as was done last year. (copy enclosed for reference).

I appreciate the efforts of your Ministry towards providing support to the States/ UTs to manage the COVID-19 pandemic, through a comprehensive response and with a 'Whole of Government' approach. In the prevailing situation, it is imperative that through our combined efforts, availability of sufficient health care infrastructure is ensured in the States to help them meet the increased demand for providing proper care and treatment to those affected by Covid-19.

Central Ministries have issued directions to the hospitals under their control for making available beds for providing treatment to those affected by Covid-19. However, during recent interactions with States/ Districts it has been brought out that some of these hospitals do not have adequate number of trained manpower and requisite equipments.

I would, therefore, request you to kindly ensure that not only the beds in these hospitals are made available to the State/ District Authorities for management of Covid cases, but also that these hospitals are provided with the requisite equipments and manpower. These dedicated hospitals or blocks may be equipped to provide all supportive and ancillary services including Oxygen supported beds, ICU beds, Ventilators and specialized Critical Care Units (wherever available), laboratory services, imaging services, etc. along with dedicated and trained health work-force.



Dear Colleague,

As you are aware the country is facing a second surge of the COVID-19 pandemic currently. In order to strengthen the efforts of States/UTs to effectively prepare their health systems to manage this pandemic, the Government of India is following Comprehensive response with a 'Whole of Government' approach. As part of this response, several ministries of the Government of India and the Empowered Groups are working in tandem to manage the situation effectively and to provide all required support to the States/UTs that are at fore-front of handling this pandemic.

2. The need of the hour is to prioritize and systematize all our combined efforts towards effective management and ensure availability of sufficient health care infrastructure in the States/UTs to meet the increased demand for providing proper care & treatment to COVID-19 patients.
3. To support the efforts of the States/UTs, the Central Ministries and Departments having the hospitals under their direct control or under the control of their PSUs, had prepared isolation beds and facilities with ICUs, ventilators etc, in hospitals under their control, for the treatment of COVID19 patients during the previous year. The present situation of sudden surge in the COVID cases across the country calls for similar supportive action from all such Central Ministries / Departments and their PSUs & the Hospitals under their control.
4. I, therefore, request you to issue instructions to the hospitals under the control of your departments/PSUs to set-up exclusive dedicated hospitals or separate blocks within the hospitals (both for OPD as well as IPD care) for Covid Care, as done last year. These Hospitals/Blocks should have separate entry and exit points for the management of COVID19 cases, to provide treatment services including specialised care for the confirmed COVID19 cases. These dedicated hospitals or blocks have to be equipped to provide all supportive and ancillary services including Oxygen supported beds, ICU beds, Ventilators and specialised Critical Care Units (wherever available), laboratory services, imaging services, kitchen, laundry etc along with dedicated health work-force.
5. As the present situation demands the support from you like last year, I therefore, request you to kindly ensure that maximum possible dedicated hospitals/blocks for COVID19 case management are earmarked and prepared immediately. I also request that the details of such dedicated hospitals/blocks, are provided to the public, duly coordinating with the respective health departments of States/UTs and the District Health Administration of the States/Districts wherever these hospitals are located, so that the public may avail the required treatment at these hospitals / blocks. A Nodal Officer may be nominated from the Ministry / Department for necessary coordination with the respective States/UTs for this purpose and their contact details be shared with the respective States/UTs as well as MoHFW.
