Technical Report

The Administrative approval and the Expenditure Sanction of this work were communicated by the Lakshadweep administration for an amount of Rs. 1973.08 lakhs. The work has actually started during the month of February 2015 and could be completed in March 2018.

The phase I of this complex comprises of 10 blocks of the buildings.

* 4 nos type IV quarters in single block which houses a Living cum dining, 3 bedrooms - one with attached toilet, Kitchen and a beautiful balcony having a sea face. The total plinth area of this block is 368.80 sqm.

* 12 Nos type III quarters in 2 blocks with each blocks consisting of 6 quarters each. Each quarter housing a Living cum dining 2 bedrooms, Kitchen and a balcony in the bed room. The total plinth area of these blocks is 747 sqm.

* 40 Nos type II quarters in 7 blocks, 6 blocks with 12 quarters and 1 block with 4 quarters. Each quarter houses a Living room, Dining room, Kitchen and Balcony in the bedroom. The total plinth area of these blocks is 2052 sqm.

* Separate septic tanks working under the principle of bio digester for all the blocks are provided as per the patented version of DRDO, Ministry of Defence, Government of India.

2 Nos. of underground water tanks, each 50000 liters capacity and 2 Nos of 25000 liters capacity overhead tanks are provided to augment the well water and treated water/rain water for water supply requirements on both east and west campus.

The project is designed as RCC framed structure with burnt bricks as filler walls. The orientation of the buildings are planned to reduce the ingress of solar radiation. Large openings are provided for excellent ventilation. Building punctures are designed to aid cross ventilation. Necessary provisions are made in the structural design of the buildings to make it earthquake resistant. Minimum quantity of timber is used in these buildings to prevent/ minimize felling of trees and towards the

concern of depleting ground water table due to indiscriminate sand mining thereby causing severe drought and other environmental hazards crushed stone sand is used in all the concrete and other allied works. Fusion bonded epoxy coated thermo mechanically treated steel bars are used as reinforcement to protect the structure from corrosion as the Lakshadweep islands falls under severe corrosion affected area. All the HDPE bags brought from the mainland to transport the material are taken back to the mainland itself for disposal and to support the Lakshadweep bio-diversity minimizing the hazard due to plastic waste in the Island. As per the requirement of the Lakshadweep islands the vertical expansion is restricted to (G + 2) floors. The future expansion is in pipe line to house one Type V quarter and an Officers' mess. This is the part of the master plan already approved by the Lakshadweep Administration. This complex is housed in land of **6136.32** and the total built-up area of this phase is **3167.8 sqm**.

New Delhi : India and Panama have signed two agreements on exemption of Visas for holders of Diplomatic and Official Passports and in the field of Agriculture.

These agreements were signed in the presence of Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu and President of Panama Juan Carlos Varela Rodrigues and Vice President and Foreign Minister Isabel de Saint Malo de Alvarado in Panama city last night.

In a joint statement, Mr Naidu and Panama's President said that India and Panama always had cordial relations. They said, these ties are based on our common values and a shared commitment to democracy, pluralism,

multi-culturalism, and the rule of law.

"The Vice President said that both the countries resolve to combat terrorism in all its forms and manifestations. Mr. Naidu lauded Panama for including India for strengthening relations for its Falcon policies.

He also said that two centres for Biodiversity and Innovation will be setup by India in Panama worth US \$10 mn and US \$15 mn each.

The Vice President further added that in order to boost cooperation in key areas both the countries have agreed to strengthen cooperation in tax information, economic cooperation, air services, traditional medicines, culture and space.

India to host 15th Asia Media Summit from today

New Delhi : India will host the 15th Asia Media Summit from today in which representatives from nearly 40 countries will discuss on issues related to the media sector. New Delhi is hosting the annual summit of the Asia-Pacific Institute for Broadcasting Development (AIBD) Kuala Lumpur for the first time.

Zubin Irani will deliver the key note address at the inaugural session. The theme of the summit is "Telling Our Stories - Asia and More".
