Cabinet approves changes in triple talaq bill

New Delhi: The Union Cabinet approved changes in triple talaq bill and includes the provision of granting bail to men found guilty of giving instant triple talaq to their wives.

Talking to reporters after cabinet meeting in New Delhi, Law Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad said, the cabinet has approved three amendments to the Muslim Women Protection of Rights on Marriage Bill which has been cleared by Lok Sabha and pending approval of Rajya Sabha.

Tomorrow is the last day of the Monsoon Session of Parliament and the government could introduce amendments in Rajya Sabha.

If the bill is cleared by the upper house, it will have to go back to Lok Sabha for approval of the amendments.

National Sports University Bill passed in Parliament

New Delhi: Parliament has passed the National Sports University Bill 2018 with the Rajya Sabha approving it.

The Lok Sabha had passed the Bill last week. The Bill seeks to establish a first-of-its-kind National Sports University in Manipur for the promotion of sports.

Replying to a debate on the bill, Sports Minister Col Rajyavardhan Rathore said, the Chancellor of the University will be

Mr Rathore said, it is a major step towards bringing to reality Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of developing a world-class 360-degree sports ecosystem in India.

stipend as well as food and supplement allowance. He informed that Government is developing a Mobile App which will have information about sports academies and centres.

He said, it is everyone's responsibility to take sports forward, be it central government or private sector.

He said, National sports development funding has helped so far and we won't let anyone go without funding.

India to launch its 2nd lunar mission Chandrayaan-2 on January 3 next year

New Delhi : India will launch its second lunar mission "Chandrayaan-2" on January 3 next year to land on the moon with a lander and rover.

Talking to news persons in Bengaluru, Indian Space Research Organisation Chairman K. Sivan said that the ISRO is aiming to launch the mission on January 3 next year but the window to land on the lunar surface is open till March 2019.

The 800-crore rupees lunar mission named "Chandrayaan-2" comes over a decade after India went up to the lunar orbit in November 8, 2008 after "Chandrayaan-1" launch on October 22 onboard a Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle rocket from the spaceport in Sriharikota in Andhra Pradesh.

The 3,890-kg Chandrayaan-2, which will be launched onboard the Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle Mk-3, will orbit around the moon and study its lunar conditions to collect data on its topography, mineralogy and exosphere.

This is the first time India will have a rover landing on the moon nearly 50 years after American astronaut Neil Armstrong walked on the eerie lunar surface in 1969.

ISRO will launch 50 satellites in next three years

New Delhi : The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will launch 50 satellites in the next three years to meet the growing demand for space applications in India. Dr. Sivan said, two launches will be planned every month from February next year, which he said, will be a record in the history of space programme. The Chairman also said, Chandrayaan II mission to moon with a lander is planned in January next year. ISRO will also launch two demonstration flights of Small Satellite Launch Vehicle in mid of next year.
