No proposal to alter age criteria for Civil Service examinations, clarifies govt

New Delhi : There is no proposal to alter the age criteria of eligibility for civil service examinations, the government clarified on Tuesday.

Minister of State in the Prime Minister's State Office and Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Dr Jitendra Singh said, no such proposal is being considered by the Centre. He said, all the reports and speculations should be put to rest in this regard.

Earlier, there were media reports suggesting that the Centre may lower the upper age limit for entry into the civil services and the age may be brought down to 27 years for general category candidates in a phased manner by 2022-23.

Currently, the upper age limit remains 32 years for candidates belonging to general category. For candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes category, the upper age limit to appear for the exam remains 37 years.

OFFICE CIRCULAR

The Department of Education, Union Territory of Lakshadweep has been allotting seats for Higher Studies through online allotment system, but despite repeated instructions from the Department it is noticed that the candidates, because of their lack of knowledge about the academic nature of various courses of different Universities and their admission procedure, the candidates repeatedly request the Department to relax the admission norms in favour of them. The Government of India and Various State Governments are reserving seats for Lakshadweep but the basic admissions rules set by the Government/instructions/universities cannot be relaxed under any circumstances.

Therefore the candidates are directed to carefully go through the admission prospectus/Guidelines of Professional and Non Professional Courses before participating in the seat allotment process. Candidate may ensure the following basic aspects of the admission process adopted for various courses.

1. Entrance Examinations :- Candidates aspiring for Professional and Non Professional Courses (MBBS/BDS/Engineering/Ayush) Agriculture/Fisheries/Law/Nursing/Business studies and all other courses) need to qualify the Entrance Examinations conducted at National/State/University or Institution as per the instructions of the Ministry or the apex body in the field concerned. The candidates are required to furnish their Entrance ranking position in the application for seat allotment. Therefore all the candidates are here by informed to attend Entrance Examinations as per the Schedule published by the agencies concerned.

2. Selection of the Course :- It is obligatory from the part of the candidates to verify the complete details of the course, the Institution, fees structure, hostel and other facilities before selecting a course through online allotment since the Department shall not able to modify the selection at any stage.

3. Mandatory documents :- The candidates have to submit whatever documents demanded by the Department for the purpose of seat allotment and also need to produce all the Certificates, Mandatory ID proofs etc. demanded by the institution at the time of admission.

4. Public Notices/Circular :- Submission of Online application for Seat allotment for the Higher Studies Courses for the academic year will start during the Month of April/May and Circular/Public Notices in this regard will be published in the Official Website of the U. T. of Lakshadweep and also available with the Principals of all island/E.O. Kochi. The copy of the circular will be available with the DC/SDO in island concerned. Hence the parents and students may watch for the communications from the Department for latest update.

Candidates aspiring seats for higher studies from Lakshadweep quota are directed to strictly comply with the above instructions and ensure that they are fulfilling all the eligibility criterions for the course before selecting course through online allotment since the Department will not be responsible if the candidate failed to get admission after allotment.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) published Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) principal notification on 14th September, 2006, mandate prior environmental clearance for identified projects and activities. Further, the MoEF&CC has decentralized the powers for grant of environmental clearance in respect of Category "B" projects to the respective State/UT Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) in order to facilitate expeditious clearance. For the purpose of assisting the Authority, the central government, in consultation with UT government can appoint State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) for the purpose.

The Union Territory of Lakshadweep therefore invites application from eligible Indian citizens for the recommendation/appointment of Chairman/member in SEIAA/SEAC for UTLA as per the qualification, age, criteria etc. shown below:

1. The selected individuals through consultation process will be recommended to Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) to be appointed as Chairman/Members in SEIAA/SEAC of Union territory of Lakshadweep.

2. The Authority/SEAC shall hold the office for a term of three years from the date of notification publishes by central government in the official gazette.

3. The Authority/SEAC shall exercise the powers and follow the procedures as specified in the said Gazette Notification.

4. The Authority shall base its decision on the recommendation of the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) constituted under the above notification.

5. The Chairman shall nominate one of the members as the Vice Chairman who shall preside over the SEAC in the absence of Chairman.

6. The Chairman/members may not be removed prior to expiry of the tenure without cause and proper enquiry.

7. The term "Expert/Professional" has the same meaning as shown in the principal notification S.O.1533 (E), dated 14th September, 2006.
