

The Final Score Sheet of the 150 applicants for compassionate appointment was published for public scrutiny of all stakeholder, vide Notice F.No.A-12012/2/2018-Estt.-UT-LKS (Pt.I)/4964, dated 14<sup>th</sup> November 2018. Representations on the Final Score Sheet were received from 10 stakeholders.

	<p><b><u>Representation on final score sheet:</u></b></p> <p>As per the checklist published on 19-8-2018, I was placed as Sl.No.63 on publication of the above check list. I had submitted an application pointing out discrepancy in placing on below the person in Sl.No.12 (rs.35823), Sl.No.29 (rs.54000), Sl.No.35 (rs.48086), Sl.No.43 (rs.34500) and Sl.No.58 (rs.91666), since there are earning members in their family and they have more family</p> <p><b><u>Decision of the Committee in the Review Meeting:</u></b></p> <p>The grievances adduced by him, vide his representation dated 19-9-2018 has already been examined thoroughly and disposed off vide Notice F.No.A-12012/2/2018-Estt.-UT-LKS (Pt.I)/4964, dated 14-11-2018. He has not pointed out any specific mistake in the details in respect of him. Further, he has not submitted any documentary evidence to prove the mistake of others at any point of time.</p>

	<p><b><u>Representation on final score sheet:</u></b></p> <p>As per the Annexure of Notice cited first, for compassionate appointment, my name is placed in serial No.88 Abdullakoya. M. C. In this connection, I submitted a representation to the Director Services vide reference cited 2 (application dated 30-9-2018), pointing out the discrepancies related with my family income which is entered wrongly. In Col.12 income from the properties is shown wrongly as ₹24,000/-. When I represented the matter to the Sub Divisional Officer, Kadmat, the Sub Divisional Officer, Kadmat in his letter vide reference cited 3rd dated 11-10-2018 (F.No.19/10/2015-SDO Kadmat (part) dated 11-10-2018 of SDO, Kadmat) informed the Director Services that the income was wrongly entered as ₹24000/- instead of ₹2400/-. He requested to rectify the income from ₹24000/- to ₹2400/-. Unfortunately it is seen that no action is taken to rectify the error till date. If the wrong entry in income is not rectified, my chance for getting the appointment will be delayed.</p> <p>In view of the above facts, I most earnestly request you sir, kindly look into the matter genuinely and sympathetically and necessary action may kindly be taken to revise the list accordingly for which act of kindness, I shall ever remain grateful to you sir.</p> <p><b><u>Decision of the Committee in the Review Meeting:</u></b></p> <p>The applicant was given opportunity to provide documentary evidence with copy of bank pass book of past one year of all the dependents of the deceased Government servant, to prove her claim. She has forwarded copy of bank pass book of her mother Smt. Ummil only for the period from 31-10-2018 to 19-12-2018, pass book of her sister Smt. Ummuhabeebath for the period from 29-8-2018 to 19-12-2018, pass book of her sister Miss. Shahila for the period from 6-1-2018 to 30-9-2018 and of herself from 6-7-2017 to 10-12-2018. She has failed to produce the details of pass book of some of the dependents of past one year and also did not produce any other documentary evidence to prove her claim that their monthly income of Rs.2,400.00. However, the Committee has taken into consideration of the available details from 1-1-2018 onwards, excluding the family pension received by the mother of the applicant and come to the conclusion that the family is getting Rs.2,400/- from their agricultural assets as reported by the Sub Divisional Officer, Kadmat and his sister is getting a family pension of Rs.18120.00. Thus, the total amount comes to Rs.20,520.00 per month. Thus, the score to be allotted is 'Zero' as per the attributes and parameters prescribed vide Office Order F.No.A-12012/2/2018-Estt.-UT-LKS (Pt.I), dated 23-3-2018. The score for which is same as published vide Notice F.No.A-12012/2/2018-Estt.-UT-LKS (Pt.I)(2), dated 14-11-2018. Hence, the Committee confirms her position at Serial No.88 in the final score sheet published Notice vide dated 14th November, 2018.</p>

**Representation on final score sheet:**

I am the native of Amini Island and belong to a poor family. I do not possess any property or do not have any regular source of income. I am single child to my parents, who got divorced when I was a child. Thereafter, my father remarried and he does not have any children in that wedlock. My father passed away on 16-12-2007. Hence, with the consent of my father's second wife, I had applied for the appointment on compassionate ground with relevant documents.

It is submitted that on 18-9-2018 the Director (Services) published a checklist of applicants those who have applied for appointment on compassionate ground. In that list my name is shown as Serial No.84 with score 46.

It is further submitted that the score was calculated under a wrongful presumption that I had received all the financial benefits and that I am presently enjoying the pension benefit of my father. Thereafter, I have filed a detailed objection against the wrongful calculation of my score in checklist dated 21-9-2018. True copy of my objection is produced herewith as Document A.

Thereafter, concerned Committee published disposal of representation on provisional score sheet on the application for compassionate appointment published by the Central Scrutiny Committee in its meeting held on 13th November, 2018. It is stated that the economic condition of the whole family has to be considered to access the economic distress of the family and not the applicant alone.

It is submitted that as I have not received any benefits that I am actually entitled to on the death of my father including the family pension, it is highly essential that the score calculation is to be reviewed and recalculated on the basis of the facts mentioned in objection, so that I can also get chance for appointment on compassionate ground.

It is most humbly submitted that I am living separately from my father's second wife and I have not received any kind of financial held and pension benefits of my father after his demise. I am facing severe financial stringencies after the demise of my father.

On the merits and circumstances explained above, I humbly requested that your good self may look into the matter and direct the Central Scrutiny Committee to reconsider my matter take necessary action to review and recalculated score in accordance with law at the earliest, in the interest of justice.

**Representation on final score sheet:**

I am an unemployed youth of Amini Island. My father died on 27-7-2008 while he was working as Head Constable in Lakshadweep Police. We are three children, out of which my elder brother and my sister got married and separated from the family before the sad demise of my father. Thereafter, I and my mother are residing at my house and struggling hard to manage our day to day life with the meager income being received from my mother's family pension account.

I have applied for compassionate appointment with relevant documents. It is submitted that on 18-9-2018, the Director (Services) published a checklist of applicants who have applied for appointment on compassionate ground. My name is shown as Serial No.131.

In check list, the monthly salary of my brother, Saleem K. K. is shown in column No.12 and in the column No.13, the value of properties of my brother is wrongly shown as my income and property and also in remarks column, it is mentioned that "Saleem" is working as Assistant Commandant in IRBn.

In is also reflected in the said list against serial Nos. 11, 16, 17 and 19 that "Considered in 2008 meeting and pending in the shoretlist 2nd time consideration", it is submitted that, I have also submitted an application for compassionate appointment in the year 2008, but the same is not mentioned against my name in the said list. Thereafter, I filed a detailed objection against wrong calculation
