The Election Commission of India vide their letter No. 23/ECI/TERR/ SOU-3/AL/2018(Part-2) dated 02.08.2018 has approved the draft list of polling stations published vide Notification F.No.16/21/2015-ELC dated 29.6.2018. NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers under section 3,6 and 25 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (Act 29 of 1986) and in suppression of Municipal Solid Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2000; the Central Government published the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 on 8th April 2016. Rule 15(e) of the said Rules made responsibility on local authorities to frame Bye-Laws incorporating all the provisions of the rules within a year from the date of notification.

Whereas, the draft of the Solid Waste Management & Sanitation Conservancy Bye-Law, 2018 were published by the Department of Environment and Forest, Union Territory Lakshadweep Administration in the Extra Ordinary Lakshadweep Gazette Vol.LIV, No.11 dated 24th July, 2018, invite objections/ suggestions from the persons likely to be affected on or before 30th August, 2018. And whereas, copies of the said notification were made available to the public on 19th July 2018.

And whereas, all objection and suggestion received in response to the above mentioned draft notification have been duly considered by the UT Administration. Now therefore, in dispensation of the duty vested under Rules 15(e) & z(f) of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and in exercise of the powers under Regulation 82(1)(a), (b), (c), (e) Regulation 82(2) of the Lakshadweep Panchayat Regulation Act, 1994, the Hon'ble Administrator hereby makes the following Bye-Laws for the management and treatment of Solid Waste namely;

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

- (a) These Bye-Laws may be called "**Lakshadweep Solid Waste Management Bye-Law, 2018**".
(b) It shall extend to the whole of U.T. of Lakshadweep.
(c) It shall come into force on such date as notified in the Official Gazette.

2. DEFINITIONS

- In these Bye-Laws, unless the context otherwise requires
- (a) **Bio degradable waste** means waste which is degradable by natural biological process and includes food leftovers, tree leaves; coconut husk and pith, paper waste but exclude human excreta.
(b) **Bio manure yard** means the area for the production of compost from biodegradable waste materials.
(c) "**Competent Authority**" means the Range Forest officer/Environment Assistant, Department of Environment & Forest/ Member Secretary, LPCC/Scientist/ Technical officer/Technical Assistant, Department of Science & Technology or any officer authorized in this behalf by the Administrator, Union Territory of Lakshadweep by notification in the official Gazette.
(d) **Central Garbage Depository** means the place or area to collect and scientifically segregate both bio degradable and non biodegradable waste generated from the territorial limit.
(e) "**Government Property**" means the solid waste, rubbish, the carcasses of dead animals deposited in any public receptacle, depot or public place collected by department to be the property of the UT administration.
(f) **Litigation** means the process of taking a case to a court of law so that a judgment can be made
(g) **Nuisance** includes any act, omission, place or thing which comes or is likely to cause injury, danger, annoyance or offence to the sense of sight, smelling or hearing or which is may be dangerous to life, injurious to health or property.
(h) **Non biodegradable waste** means waste which does not degrade by natural biological process and includes polythene, plastic, glass, tetra wastes etc.
(i) "**Prohibited substance**" means substance prohibited by notification in the official Gazette, under the Bye-Laws.
(j) **Pollution Control Committee/ State board** shall have the same definition as in (Air Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, Water (prevention & Control Pollution) Act, 1974 and Environment Protection Act, 1986.
(k) **Public place** means any such place which is open to the use and enjoyment of the public, whether it is actually used or enjoyed by the public or not.
(l) **Re-Use** means the use of a product more than once in its life time for different purposes.
(m) "**State Nodal Agency**" means the department of Environment & Forests designated to implement Municipal Solid waste in the Union Territory of Lakshadweep under Solid Waste Management Rule, 2016.
(n) Words and expressions used herein but not defined hereunder but defined in the Environment (Protection) Act 1986, the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and in the Lakshadweep Panchayat Regulations, 1994 shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the respective Acts, Rules and Regulations.

3. PROHIBITION

- a. Tender Coconut shell, tree leaves, coconut husk, coconut shell, trunks etc. in an around dwelling places / public places must be disposed scientifically by the land owner without effecting hygiene to the environment. No person is allowed to throw or break or spread coconuts, fruits leftovers, vegetables wastes on roads, foot paths, Public areas, lagoon, sea and the beaches.

- b. No person shall remove or transport hazardous wastes on or over any public road, unless such hazardous waste is securely and properly contained in separate receptacles or vehicle designated to prevent spillage or contamination.
c. Disposal by burning of any type of solid waste at road sides, beaches, and in open places is prohibited.
d. It shall be the responsibility of land/property owner to remove any obstruction caused in street by fall of trees, trunks etc. within 6 hours of such fall. If the owner fails to do so, the Competent Authority can avail all such facilities to remove the obstacles from the street and the land owner is liable for fine and / or prosecution as prescribed by these By-laws.
e. The Organizers of a public event/gathering shall clean the hired hall/ground within 24 hours from the event. If the occupier or waste generator fails to comply, the Competent Authority has power to clear and treat waste in any suitable manner and impose fine on the defaulters.
f. All the residents in the Union territory limit should maintain their peripheral area of 25 metre radius of their household litter free or else responsibility shall be fixed on dwelling house owner/resident, if found littered.
g. No person shall dump, deposit, discharge, spill or release solid waste, or cause or permit such waste to be dumped, discharged, spilled or released, whether or not the waste is in a container or receptacle, in or at any place, whether publically/ privately owned, including but not limited to vacant land, beaches, lagoon, sea, drains etc. except in a container or at a place which has been specially indicated, provided or set apart for such purpose.
h. No person shall, while driving a vehicle, or while being conveyed in a vehicle, throw or deposit solid waste on any public road or on any private premises within the territory limit, and no driver of a vehicle shall allow or permit any passenger in such vehicle to throw or deposit such waste in a like manner. The Vehicle Driver will be responsible for such violation and is liable for fine and / or prosecution.
i. No person shall use waste bin/receptacle for any other purpose than assigned for solid waste management by the Competent Authority.
j. No person shall deposit sanitary pad or diaper directly to the waste bin/receptacle. All sanitary pads should be well packed with wrap papers and should be deposited in non biodegradable waste bin for incineration.
k. The open defecation in any public or private place in the union territory limit is prohibited.
l. No person shall produce, distribute, store or sell polythene carry bags in any manner in the union territory of Lakshadweep.
m. The disposal of carcasses, fish head, chicken feather, human hair etc. in beach, lagoon or public places is prohibited.
n. Dumping and littering of solid waste in any public place and other such areas viz beaches, foot paths, road, lagoon etc meant for public utility is prohibited.
o. Unlawful and improper disposal of carcasses, rubbish, and filth in open /public places or private places is prohibited.
- 4. POWER TO DECLARE SOLID WASTE FREE/SANITATION ZONE**
The Administrator, Union Territory of Lakshadweep has the power to declare in such manner as may be prescribed, any area or areas within the Union Territory limit as sanitation zone or waste free area or areas for the purpose under this Bye-Law.
- 5. POWER TO IMPOSE USER CHARGES**
a. The Administrator, Union Territory of Lakshadweep Administration (UTLA) can impose user charges from stakeholders for the services rendered by the Administration from time to time. The User charges imposed for services such as house to house collection of solid waste, collection of solid waste from grocery, departmental and other shops, hotels, restaurants, vegetable and meat shops, school and colleges, street vendors, bulk generators etc. will be published through the official gazette of Lakshadweep.
- 6. POWER TO ISSUE DIRECTIONS**
a. If it is brought to the notice of the Competent Authority by any person or on Suomotu information, the competent authority is satisfied that any violation may take place or is or has been taking place, he/she shall have powers to issue directions to the party concerned to prevent any violation or to cease and desist from violating the provisions of these byelaws or such other directions as he/she deems fit.
- 7. PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF THE BYE LAWS**
a. Whoever violates or contravenes any provision of these Bye laws or directions issued there under by the Competent Authority shall be punishable, in respect of each such failure or contravention, with a fine as per the schedule of fine (Schedule 1) of the Bye-Laws. In case, the generator of waste is found contravening any of these Bye-Laws next time, the fine amount will be doubled. The defaulter shall be liable for prosecution if he/she fails to remit the prescribed fine within 15 days.
b. In case the person or any other generator of garbage fails to remit the fine amount as prescribed in scheduled 1, the Competent Authority in these behalf may file a complaint in the court of Competent Jurisdiction in the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. Penalties under this Bye Laws are to be tried by the Judicial Magistrate of First Class of respective island jurisdiction.
- 8. COGNIZANCE OF CONTRAVENTION**
a. No court shall take cognizance under these bye-laws except on a complaint made by
(i) Range Forest Officer/Environment Assistant of the respective Island where the contravention is reported or

(ii) Member Secretary, LPCC or
(iii) Scientist/Technical Officer/Technical Assistant under the Department of Science & Technology, UTL or an officer authorized in this behalf by the Administrator by notification in the official Gazette. No court inferior to that of a Judicial Magistrate of First Class shall try any violation punishable under this Bye Law.

9. COMPOUNDING OF PENALTIES

a. When a petition is made in this behalf and the court is satisfied that it is just and fair to do so, the court may compound any violation or contravention under these bye laws on a payment of fine of Rs. 100/- for each day during which the contravention continues.

10. AMENDMENTS OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BYE-LAWS

a. Implementation, handling and compliance of this bye-law will be amended time to time based on the rules notified/amended by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change for the management and handling of solid waste or compliance of the provisions therein.

11. HEAD OF ACCOUNT FOR THE RECEIPTS OF PENALTIES

a. The amount of fine through penalty/compounding of offence will be deposited in Department of Environment and Forest Receipt **Head 2406-Forestry and wildlife 800 other receipts.**
