Organization, DRDO. The foreign satellites include 24 from the US, two from Lithuania and one each from Spain and Switzerland. 20 of the US payloads are meant for earth observation, and are known as Flock-4A. Four other US payloads known as LEMUR are used for vessel automatic identification.

Switzerland's Astrocast-2 is involved in studies of the cutting edge Internet-of-Things technology. Aistechsat-3 of Spain is useful for remote asset management and aircraft tracking. They have all been launched under an agreement with the Antrix Corporation, the commercial arm of ISRO. CBDT Chairman appointed new Election Commissioner

New Delhi : Chairman of the Central Board of Direct Taxes, Sushil Chandra, has been appointed as the new Election Commissioner.

Mr Chandra is a 1980 batch Indian Revenue Service officer.

With his appointment, the Election Commission now has Sunil Arora as the Chief Election Commissioner and Ashok Lavasa and Sushil Chandra as fellow commissioners.

Last date to link PAN with Aadhaar extended till Sep 30

New Delhi : The government has extended the last date to link Permanent Account Number (PAN) with Aadhaar number by six month till 30th of September.

Earlier, March 31st was the last date. In a statement, Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) said, the decision to extend the deadline was taken in view of the media reports that those PANs which are not linked with Aadhaar number by yesterday may be invalidated.

The CBDT has also made it clear that it is mandatory to quote and link Aadhaar number from today in filing the Income Tax Return.

ISRO launches observation Satellite EMISAT

New Delhi : The Indian Space Research Organization, ISRO, launched India's latest satellite EMISAT and 28 other smaller satellites of international customers this morning with textbook precision. The national space agency's workhorse launch vehicle PSLV-C45, carrying the payloads on board, lifted off from its spaceport, Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikotta at

09:27 am. In a little over 17 minutes, the primary payload EMISAT has been ed by the rocket at an altitude of 754 km, as planned.

In the next one-and-a-half hours, after two rounds of engine "restart" to reduce the orbital height to 505 kilometers, the customer satellites were released into space. After reaching the planned orbital height, all 28

customer payloads were ed in space within five minutes.

Later, the remnant fourth stage of the rocket was allowed to fly further for 66 minutes by undergoing two more rounds of engine restarts. It helped to bring the engine to a height of 507 kilometers in a circular path. It is set to serve as an experimental

to get stabilized in the new orbit by 12.27 noon. In his congratulatory address to his fellow scientists, ISRO Chairman Dr Sivan said there would be thirty more ISRO missions this year. The next mission on line is the launch of a RISAT series satellite by PSLV C46 by mid-May, followed by another satellite under the Cartosat series. Chandrayaan-2 mission would be the next in line for launch. He also announced that a visitors gallery has been thrown open for the public with today's launch, which has been viewed by over 1200 people free of cost. In the next launch, 5000 people will be allowed to view from the gallery, which will gradually be increased to ten thousand.

Indian Statistical Institute presented report on VVPAT sample size to EC

New Delhi : Indian Statistical Institute presented its report on the sample size of Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail, VVPAT slip counting to the Chief Election Commissioner Sunil Arora. In a statement, the commission said, in view of the varying demands for an enhanced percentage of VVPAT Slip count during elections in the country, it had engaged the Indian Statistical Institute to systematically analyse and scientifically examine the issue of VVPAT Slip verification with an electronic count of the Electronic Voting Machines.

Breakdancing makes next move to Olympic status at Paris 2024

New Delhi : The Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) has recommended adding breakdancing, skateboarding, sport climbing and surfing to the 2024 Paris Olympic Games when the full membership meets in June. IOC President Thomas Bach said at a news conference in Switzerland that making the Olympics more affordable and responsive has been a key aim for the committee. He said, the addition of these four sports to the Paris medal program offer the opportunity to connect with the young generation. All four sports will be assessed in terms of how they are managed, the integrity of competitions and judging, before being finalized for Paris.

Vice Admiral MA Hampiholi, AVSM, NM assumes charge as Director General Naval Operations (DGNO)

New Delhi : Vice Admiral MA Hampiholi, AVSM NM has assumed charge as Director General Naval Operations today, on 27 Mar 2019. He is a graduate of the National Defence Academy and was commissioned in the Executive Branch of the Indian Navy on 01 Jul 85. The Flag Officer is a specialist in Anti-Submarine Warfare and has held important assignments both afloat and ashore. In the initial years of his career, he served onboard *INS Ships Himgiri, Agray and Ganga* as

ASW specialist officer and subsequently as an instructor at ASW Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Naval Command, Senior Directing Staff at the Naval War College, Mumbai and Principal Director Staff Requirements at Naval Headquarters. On promotion to the rank of Rear Admiral in Feb 2015, he was appointed as the Assistant Chief of Personnel (Human Resources Development), and subsequently as the Flag Officer Sea Training in Oct 16. He was later

appointed as the Flag Officer Commanding, Western Fleet in Jan 18 and Commanded the sword arm prior to his assuming of his present appointment as the Director General Naval Operations on promotion to the rank of Vice Admiral. The Admiral is a graduate from the Defence Services Staff College, Wellington and the prestigious National Defence College, New Delhi. He is a recipient of the *Nao Sena Medal* in 2011 and the *AthiVishistSeva Medal* in 2019.
