During industrialization at the beginning of the 19th Century, the industrialists used to exploit the labour class and made them work up to 15 hours a day. The workers rose against this exploitation and demanded paid leaves, proper wages and breaks for the workforce.

The day marks the victory of the workers' movement for eight hours of work. In India, the first Labour day or May Day was celebrated in 1923 in Chennai.

Indian Navy on high alert for Cyclone Fani relief efforts

New Delhi: The Eastern Naval Command has meanwhile assumed high degree of readiness to render necessary humanitarian assistance.

Indian Naval ships at Visakhapatnam and Chennai are standing-by to proceed to the most affected areas to undertake Humanitarian Aid Distress Relief, evacuation, logistic support including providing medical aid.

These ships are embarked with additional divers, doctors, inflatable rubber boats and relief material that include food, tentage, clothes, medicines, blankets etc, in quantities sufficient.

Naval aircraft are also standing by at the

Naval Air Stations INS Rajali at Arakkonam, Tamilnadu and INS Dega at Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh to undertake reconnaissance, rescue, casualty evacuation and air drop of relief material to the stranded if required. The Eastern Naval Command is monitoring the developments in the Bay of Bengal closely and Flag Officer Tamilnadu & Puducherry Naval Area and Naval Officers-in-Charge of Andhra Pradesh and Odisha are in constant communication with respective State Administrations to augment rescue and relief operations as needed.

Chandrayaan-2 to be launched in July

New Delhi: India's second lunar mission Chandrayaan-2 will be launched on a day between 9 and 16 July this year.

In a release, the Indian Space Research Organisation said, Chandrayaan-2's lander will touch down near the Moon's south pole on 6th September.

The National space agency said, Chandrayaan-2 will have three modules in it, an orbiter, a lander named Vikram and a rover known as Pragyan.

Chandrayaan-2 will be launched using India's most powerful rocket GSLV-Mark-3.

New Delhi : The first part of the Indo-French joint naval exercise, Varuna 19.1 will be conducted off the Goa coast from 1st to 10th May 19.

The upcoming 17th edition includes participation of the French Navy's aircraft carrier FNS Charles de Gaulle, two destroyers, FNS Forbin and FNS Provence, the frigate FNS Latouche-Treville, the tanker FNS Marne and a nuclear submarine. From the Indian side, the aircraft carrier INS Vikramaditya, destroyer INS Mumbai, the Teg-class frigate, INS Tarkash, the Shishumar-class submarine, INS Shankul, and the Deepak-class fleet tanker, INS Deepak, will be

PM Modi chairs high-level meet to review preparedness for cyclone 'Fani'

New Delhi : In view of cyclonic storm Fani, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has instructed senior officers of the Central Government to maintain close coordination with officers of the concerned states to ensure preventive measures, and also to take effective steps for relief and rescue operations as required. Mr. Modi today chaired a high-level meeting to review preparedness for cyclone Fani.

During the meeting, he was briefed on the likely path of the cyclone and the ongoing precautionary and

preparatory measures being undertaken. These include provision of adequate resources, deployment of teams from National Disaster Response Force and the Armed Forces, arrangements to provide drinking water and stand by systems to restore power and telecom services.

The meeting was attended by the Cabinet Secretary, Home Secretary and other senior officials from the IMD, NDRF and National Disaster Management Authority.

98.2% students pass Class 12 Boards in Trivandrum, highest in India

New Delhi : Trivandrum in Kerala is the top performing region with a pass percentage of 98.2% in Class 12 CBSE Boards, the results of which were declared on Thursday. This is followed

by the Chennai region, which has the pass percentage of 92.93%. Meanwhile, the overall pass percentage of 83.4% has been recorded in the exams.

Agencies ready to meet any eventuality arising out of cyclone Fani

New Delhi : Central and State agencies are fully geared to meet any eventuality arising out of cyclone Fani. Defence forces are prepared as Odisha braces for the cyclonic storm.

The extremely severe cyclonic storm is likely to make landfall near Puri tomorrow with wind speeds ranging up to 180 kilometres per hour.

The storm is likely to impact coastal districts of Odisha including Ganjam, Gajapati, Khurda, Puri and Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapada, Bhadrak, Jajpur and Balasore.

Under the influence of the Cyclone, squally winds gusting up to 85 km per hour are expected tonight along and off the North Andhra Pradesh Coast.

The Indian Coast Guard and the Navy have deployed ships and

helicopters for relief and rescue operations. Army and Air Force units in the three States have also been put on standby.

NDRF has deployed 28 teams in Odisha, 12 in Andhra Pradesh and 6 in West Bengal. Additionally, 32 teams have been kept on standby.

Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik reviewed the preparedness and said around eight lakh people will be evacuated from vulnerable areas to safe places by Thursday evening.

Special Relief Commissioner BP Sethi said, 880 cyclone shelters in coastal and southern districts have been kept ready to accommodate the evacuees.

One lakh dry food packets are being kept ready at different places.

Leave of all doctors and health officials and police personnel have been cancelled.

74 trains have been cancelled under East Coast Railway Zone.

Educational institutions have been asked to remain closed for three days from today.

The Centre has directed that all necessary measures be taken to complete evacuation of people from areas in the path of the Cyclone. at the meeting of National Crisis Management Committee (NCMC) in New Delhi yesterday, Cabinet Secretary PK Sinha again reviewed the preparedness of the State and Central Agencies concerned to deal with the situation arising out of the Cyclone.

The NCMC will meet again today to take stock of the situation.

CBSE Class XII results announced

New Delhi : The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) announced Class 12th results on Thursday.

The results are available on the official website www.cbse.nic.in.

Microsoft and Google have partnered with CBSE to make it easier for students to find their results and other e x a m - r e l a t e d information.

Students have to go to google.com and type CBSE result to get the pertinent link.

Around 13 lakh students appeared for the Class 12 examination conducted by the CBSE.

The CBSE post-result counselling will begin from today and will continue till 16th of this month.

The Board said, the counsellings will start from 8 am to 10 pm on all days. For the 22nd consecutive year, the CBSE will be providing counselling services to students and parents to overcome common psychological problems and general queries related to 10th and 12th results.

Air Marshal Rakesh Kumar Singh Bhadauria takes over as Vice Chief of Air Staff

New Delhi : Air Marshal Rakesh Kumar Singh Bhadauria took over as Vice Chief of the Air Staff.

An alumnus of the National Defence Academy, Air Marshal Bhadauria was commissioned in the fighter stream of Indian Air Force in 1980 and won the coveted 'Sword of Honour' for standing first in the overall order of merit.

He has over 4250 hours of experience on twenty-six types of fighters and transport aircraft with the unique distinction of being an Experimental Test Pilot, a Cat 'A' Qualified Flying Instructor and a Pilot Attack Instructor. He completed his Masters in Defence Studies from Command and Staff College, Bangladesh.

The Air Marshal has held a number of important appointments, which include, Command of a Jaguar Squadron and a premier Air Force Station, Commanding Officer of Flight Test Squadron at Aircraft and

System Testing Establishment, Chief Test Pilot and Project Director of National Flight Test Centre on Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) project.

He was extensively involved in the initial prototype flight tests on the LCA. Air Marshal Bhadauria was also the Air Attache, at Embassy of India in Moscow, Assistant Chief of the Air Staff (Projects), Commandant of the National Defence Academy, Senior Air Staff Officer at HQ CAC, Deputy Chief of the Air Staff at Air HQ and Air Officer Commanding-in-Chief of Southern Air Command. Prior to assuming the present appointment, he was the Air Officer Commanding-in-Chief of Training Command.

During his illustrious career, he was commended by the Chief of Air Staff and has been awarded Param Vishist Seva Medal, Ati Vishist Seva Medal and Vayu Sena Medal.
