## Narendra Modi takes oath as PM for second term



Shri. Narendra Modi sworn as Prime Minister : Shri. Ram Nath Kovind administering the oath of Office to Narendra Modi in a ceremony on the forecourts of the Rashtrapati Bhawan.

**New Delhi :** National Democratic Alliance leader Shri. Narendra Modi was sworn in as Prime Minister for the second consecutive term.

President Shri. Ram Nath Kovind administered the oath of Office to him and a team of 57 ministers at a glittering ceremony on the forecourts of the Rashtrapati Bhawan just before sunset.

Besides 24 Cabinet ministers including Shri. Amit Shah, Shri. Rajnath Singh, Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman, Shri. Nitin Gadkari, Smt. Smriti Irani, and Shri. Piyush Goyal, nine were sworn in as Minister of State with Independent charge and another 24 as Minister of State.

One-third of the total ministers in the Cabinet are first-timers, including BJP president Shri. Amit Shah and former Foreign Secretary Shri. Subrahmanya Jaishankar. Two former Chief Ministers - Shri. Ramesh Pokhriyal from Uttarakhand and Shri. Arjun Munda from Jharkhand - have taken oath as Union ministers for the first time.

This will be the first innings for six Cabinet ministers and 13 Ministers of State. BJP's Shri. Prahlad Joshi and Shri. Shiv Sena's Arvind Sawant will also become Union ministers for the first time.

The new Modi Government has the

maximum representation of 10 faces from Uttar Pradesh, followed by seven from Maharashtra, six from Bihar and four from Madhya Pradesh.

It also has three ministers each from Gujarat, Rajasthan, Haryana and Karnataka followed by two each from West Bengal and Odisha.

The function was attended by leaders from BIMSTEC countries and foreign envoys, Governors, Chief Ministers, Opposition leaders, corporate heads and film stars.

President of Sri Lanka Maithripala Sirisena, President of Myanmar, U Win Myint, President of

Bangladesh, Md. Abdul Hamid, Prime Minister of Bhutan, Dr Lotay Tshering, Prime Minister of Nepal, Shri. K.P Sharma Oli, Special Envoy of Thailand, Shri. Grisada Boonrach, President of the Kyrgyz Republic, Sooronbay Jeenbekov and Prime Minister of Mauritius, Pravind Jugnauth witnessed the event.

Key leaders of the Opposition who were present at the event were Congress President Rahul Gandhi, UPA Chairperson Sonia Gandhi, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and Samajwadi Party patron Mulayam Singh Yadav.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> State Level Advisory Body on Solid Waste Management Meeting Held

## Vice President appeals people not to come to hasty conclusions on New Education Policy

**New Delhi :** Vice President Shri. M Venkaiah Naidu has appealed to the people to study, analyse and debate the draft of New Education Policy and not to come to hasty conclusions.

Observing that core issues of education were very important and deserve the attention of all stakeholders, he said that reducing the load of school bags, promoting sports, inculcating morals, scientific and rationale temperament, history and the contribution of the freedom fighters should become a part of the curriculum.

Inaugurating a two-day conference on 'Industry Academy Interaction for Improvement of Quality of Academics' organised by the Indian Institute of Petroleum and

Energy (IIFE) in Vishakhapatnam, Mr. Naidu called for establishing a symbiotic relationship between academia and the industry to create an ecosystem for innovation to thrive and generate employment for the youth.

Calling for a revamp of the education system so that the graduating students were fully equipped with skills to meet the needs of the industry or agriculture or have the aptitude and skills of a risk-taking entrepreneur, the Vice President said the students must not only be employable but also possess life skills, language skills, technological skills, and entrepreneurial skills to enable them to be gainfully employed or self-employed.

## Draft National Education Policy revised; choice of available languages left to state boards

**New Delhi :** The Kasturirangan committee has revised the Draft New National Education Policy and effected some changes in the three-language formula.

The committee informed the government that there had been an inadvertent error in the draft submitted for public feedback.

The committee said the revised draft has now been uploaded for feedback from states and public for a period of 30 days.

The government has clarified that the draft was recommendatory and has been revised to say the students be given flexibility over choice of language under the three-language model in the schools. In the revised draft the choice of available languages has been left to the state boards.

HRD Secretary Shri. R Subrahmanyam has reiterated that the draft is not government policy but recommendations of the committee. External Affairs Minister Shri. S Jaishankar had also said that the all stakeholders - general public and state governments - will be consulted before taking a final call on the three-language norm.

## Landmark decision taken in the first Cabinet meeting of the NDA Government offers pension coverage to crores of farmers

Pension scheme to secure lives of 5 crore farmers in three years

This scheme, in addition to PM-KISAN monetary support will ease economic burden and lead to greater efficiency

**New Delhi :** The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved a new Central Sector Scheme, a historic decision that will empower farmers across India. This is a path breaking scheme that will provide pension cover to our industrious farmers who toil day and night to keep our nation fed. It is also for the first time since independence that such a pension coverage has been envisioned for farmers.

It is estimated that 5 crore small and marginal farmers will benefit in the first three years itself. The Central Government would spend Rs. 10774.50 crore for a period of 3 years towards its contribution (matching share) for providing social security cover as envisaged under the scheme.

### The salient features of this scheme are:

A voluntary and contributory pension scheme for all Small and Marginal Farmers (SMF) across the country. Entry age of 18 to 40 years with a provision of minimum fixed pension of Rs.3,000/- on attaining the age of 60 years.

For example, a beneficiary farmer is required to contribute Rs 100/- per month at median entry age of 29 years. The Central Government shall also contribute to the Pension Fund an equal amount as contributed by the eligible farmer.

After the subscriber's death, while receiving pension, the spouse of the SMF beneficiary shall be entitled to receive 50% of the pension received by the beneficiary as family pension, provided he/she is not already an SMF beneficiary of the Scheme. If, the death of the subscriber happens during the period of contribution, the spouse shall have the option of continuing the Scheme by paying regular contribution.

### Synergy between schemes, prosperity for farmers:

An interesting feature of the Scheme is that the farmers can opt to allow his/her monthly contribution to the Scheme to be made from the benefits drawn from the Pradhan Mantri KisanSAMman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) Scheme directly. Alternatively, a farmer can pay his monthly contribution by registering through Common Service Centres (CSCs) under MeitY.

### Fulfilling core promises, empowering the agriculture sector:

For seventy years after Independence, such a coverage for farmers was never thought. It was in the run up to the 2019 Parliamentary elections that PM Narendra Modi first mooted such an idea, which gradually found resonance across the length and breadth of India. Such a plan was mentioned in the BJP manifesto and in the first Cabinet meeting after the formation of a new Government, it has become a reality.
