CCTNS Refresher Training Course at PHQ

Kavaratti : In continuation to the Change Management workshop organized by the Lakshadweep Police Department (LPD), to empower their workforce on ambitious and prestigious project 'Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and Systems (CCTNS)' of Ministry of Home Affairs, GoI, a 13 days of CCTNS Refresher Training program from June 24, 2019 onwards, has been organized at District Training Centre (DTC), Police Headquarters, Kavaratti. For this refresher training, more than 52 police personnel who voluntarily desired to participate, has been invited from all Islands, to have further hands on training each modules of CCTNS applications.

The CCTNS Programme was conceived as a Mission Mode Project fully sponsored by the Government of India under the National e-Governance Programme (NeGP). Ministry of Home Affairs and National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) are implementing the project across the country with the help and support of State Governments and Union Territories. NCRB is the central nodal agency that would manage CCTNS.

The broad objectives of the CCTNS project are

streamlining investigation and prosecution processes, strengthening of intelligence gathering machinery, improved public delivery system and citizen-friendly interface, nationwide sharing of information across on crime and criminals and improving efficiency and effectiveness of police functioning. CCTNS aims at creation of a comprehensive and integrated application platform and a nationwide networked environment for sharing real-time crime and criminal information across 15000+ police stations, 6000+ higher offices and associated departments in all states and UTs of the country.

The dignitaries Shri. Ram Dulesh Meena, DANIPS, Project Director (CCTNS), Shri. B. Mohammed CI (HQ), Shri M.P. Najmudheen (CI), Shri. Ajmal Khan V (SHO Kavaratti) of the Police Department occasioned the inaugural ceremony. Shri. Ram Dulesh Meena inaugurated the ceremony

and mentioned that the main objective of this refresher training (Train to Trainers) is to train their key police personnel who can later train the rest of the police staff. Further, Shri. Ram Dulesh Meena mentioned that the Lakshadweep Police department is planning to go for paper less police stations from August 2019 onwards, so it is imperative for the participant to make maximum use of this training program and explore each modules of the CCTNS application, which should help them to perform their working functions and operations like General Diary, IIF Forms, Investigation, Report generation, etc. completely online to work further effectively and efficiently.

This refresher training is being imparted in two batches, each batch of 26 police personnel, by the System Integrator M/s TCS and assisted by State Project Management Unit (M/s Deloitte) for CCTNS project.

Lakshadweep Electricity Dept. for FY 2019-20**

1. The revised Tariff in respect of Lakshadweep Electricity Department for the financial year 2019-2020 approved by the Joint Electricity Regulatory Commission for the state of GOA and Union Territories is here by published for the information of general public and all concerned as detailed below.

2. Net revenue requirement for FY 2019-20 approved by the commission is Rs. 135.71 Crores against the revenue of Rs. 23.94 Crores calculated from revised tariff thereby creating a gap of Rs.110.28 Crores. The following are considered while arriving at the category wise tariff approved.

3. The average cost of supply for FY 2019-20 is estimated at Rs.25.39/kWh.

4. The Commission has approved a marginal increase of 6.21% in retail tariff for FY 2019-20.

5. Having considered the Petition No. 273/2018 of Lakshadweep Electricity Department for Annual Performance Review for FY 2018-19 and Determination of retail tariffs for supply of electricity for FY 2019-20, the Commission approves the retail tariff for Lakshadweep ED for FY 2019-20 as below.

6. The breakup of the Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) approved for Lakshadweep Electricity Department for FY 2019-20 is given below:

The approved retail tariff (as given below) shall be in accordance with the tariff schedule specified in the Tariff Order to meet the ARR of FY 2019-20.

Category wise Approved Tariff for FY 2019-20

The Commission has abolished BPL / Kutir Jyoti consumer category and has introduced a new category of Life line Connection for consumers having consumption upto 50 units in order to provide benefit of lower tariff to the weaker section of the society having consumption upto 50 units per month.

The Commission believe that the demand for charging infrastructure for electric vehicles will increase in the near future due to increased commercialization and hence the commission introduced a new category namely Electric Vehicle Charging Stations for consumers setting up infrastructure for charging of Electric Vehicles.

The Commission has introduced Two Part Tariff system for the consumer category Public Lighting.
