## Stage set for separation of lander Vikram from Chandrayaan 2 Orbiter

**New Delhi :** The stage is all set for the crucial separation of lander Vikram from Chandrayaan 2 Orbiter this afternoon. According to ISRO, the separation is scheduled between 12:45 PM and 1:45 PM. The separation will allow the lander to travel towards the lunar surface, leaving the Orbiter to continue to revolve around the moon.

Yesterday evening, ISRO successfully carried out fifth and final orbit manoeuvre of Chandrayaan 2 to refine its circular path around the moon. The orbiter will remain in its orbit for a planned one year. The composite Chandrayaan-2 has the orbiter, the lander and the rover. The 1.5-ton lander carries in its belly the 27 kg rover. The mission of the lander is to soft-land on the lunar South Pole and to safely unleash the rover.

The lander and the rover have a mission life of a single lunar day or 14 days of the earth.

The rover Pragyaan has two devices to probe the elemental composition of lunar soil near its landing site and derive the elemental abundance there.

The powered descent of the lander will be initiated early on September 7, resulting in its much-awaited soft-landing on the near-South Pole of the moon. After a few hours of soft-landing, the rover will come out of the lander's belly and probe the nature of the lunar soil around its path. Once the mission is realized, India will become the fourth country to achieve soft-landing on the moon.

India has prior experience of deploying orbiters around celestial bodies, the first one around the moon in the

## EC launches Electors Verification Programme

**New Delhi :** The Election Commission today launched new mega Electors Verification Programme (EVP) across the country. The programme, which seeks to electoral rolls through crowd sourcing, will go on till 15<sup>th</sup> of October.

Under the programme, a voter from each family will get a username and password, allowing a person to upload all documents related to electoral registration and tag similar details about his or her family members.

These details will then be verified by block-level officers. It will be

done by 36 CEOs at the state headquarters level, by 740 district electoral officers at the district level and by BLOs and electoral registration officers in around one million polling stations.

The EVP programme can be effected both online and offline.

On the occasion of the nationwide mega million launch of Electors Verification

Programme, a special camp was held at Election Commission Headquarters in New Delhi.

Unveiling the initiative, Chief Election Commissioner Sunil Arora said the electoral roll is the foundation on which the entire superstructure of the Election Commission stands. He urged all the citizens to participate in the verification

programmes so that the Commission can provide better electoral services in all forthcoming elections.

Reiterating the importance of a healthy electoral roll, Election Commissioner Ashok Lavasa said, the participation of people is paramount to the success of the drive and urged all to come forward and ensure an error-free Electoral Roll.

## Non-subsidised LPG price hiked by Rs 15.50

**New Delhi :** The price of non-subsidised cooking gas (LPG) was hiked by 15 rupees and 50 paise per cylinder. According to the Indian Oil Corporation, it will now cost 590 rupees per cylinder in Delhi.

The price of Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF) was, however, cut by 596 rupees and 62paise per kilolitre. It will now be available at 62 thousand 698 rupees and 86paise per

kilolitre. The price cut of nearly one per cent is due to softening international oil prices. This is the third straight monthly price reduction of the fuel.
