As a teacher of English in Lakshadweep, Dr Abdul Hakeem has always endeavoured to improve english teaching at all levels, and tried his best to make learning of english interesting and profitable by resorting to some innovative modes.

In Minicoy, where technological development was sparse, persistent efforts were needed to set an E-Class room for the students to read newspapers and other textual online resources in his school.

He also devised speaking exercises and the weekly programme "Happy Reading and Review" to encourage extra reading,

reviewing, and for improving the writing skills, for cultivating library culture and providing research orientation.

The three day 'English Living Camp' REEF (Rapid and Effective English Formulation) to improve the basic skills of the students in English has been well received and appreciated so far.

Published an E-Book named Know Your Question Paper in his blog (hakeemenglish.blogspot.com) which was widely appreciated by teachers through mathsblog, a popular online academic platform in Kerala and was applauded by the Director of Education, UTL for the pioneering effort.

Shouldered responsibilities as

members of a committee constituted for setting up of Language Labs and Smart Class rooms, Convenor for School/Subject Resource Group (English) for conducting teacher training workshops, SAGY, Legal Literacy Club, Guidance and Counselling, ASL classes, and night classes for the late bloomers.

Dr. Abdul Hakeem also presented papers in the five International English Language Teachers' Association of India (ELTAI) Conferences. His article 'Problems and Prospects of English language teaching and learning in Lakshadweep' is published in the book titled *The Multi Lingual Education in India- The case for English*, Viva Books (See page 2, col. 1)

**New Delhi :** The admission portal for the programme is being executed by IIT Delhi for offering PhD fellowships to ASEAN students in all IITs in India.

The lunch ceremony of the ASEAN PhD fellowships at IITs will be held on Monday and will be jointly inaugurated by External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar and Minister of HRD Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank'.

Head of Missions of ASEAN countries, senior officials of the Ministry of External Affairs, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Directors of all 23 IITs, Chairman of UGC and Vice Chairman of NITI Aayog would also be present at the event.

## PM Modi launches Kisan Maan Dhan Yojana from Ranchi

**New Delhi :** Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi launched Kisan Maan Dhan Yojana from Ranchi today. The scheme will secure the lives of five crore small and marginal farmers by providing a minimum pension of three thousand rupees per month, to those who attain 60 years of age. The scheme has an outlay of 10 thousand 774 crore rupees for the next three years. All small and marginal farmers who are currently between the ages of 18 to 40 years can apply for the scheme.

In Jharkhand, more than 1.16 lakh farmers have registered themselves under the scheme so far. Only small and marginal farmers, who own cultivable land upto two hectares would be eligible for the scheme.

The Prime also unveiled India's second riverine multi model terminal, built at Sahebganj in Jharkhand. He inaugurated it through a digital communication system at a function in Ranchi. Mr Modi also laid

the foundation of Jharkhand Secretariat building. He also inaugurated the newly constructed Jharkhand Assembly building at Dhurwa in the state capital

Mr Modi also launched 462 Eklavya Model Residential Schools in the country. Sixty-nine such schools will be started in Jharkhand. The Prime Minister also launched Vyapar Swarojgar Pension Scheme for small traders.

## 38<sup>th</sup> Sharjah Intl. Book Fair to be organized from 30<sup>th</sup> Oct to 9<sup>th</sup> of Nov

**New Delhi :** The 38<sup>th</sup> edition of the Sharjah International Book Fair (SIBF) will be organized from 30<sup>th</sup> of October to 9<sup>th</sup> of November this year, where authors, publishers, intellectuals and artists worldwide will bring their experiences and expertise to this prominent event and partake in a vibrant cultural programme.

UNESCO has named Sharjah as the World Book Capital City for the year 2019 in recognition of the city's continuous efforts in promoting books and literacy.

Aligning itself with the title of the World Book Capital, the SIBF will be organized under the theme 'Open Books, Open Minds'.

Sharjah Book Authority (SBA) Chairman Ahmed bin Rakkad Al Ameri, in a statement said that it will be an exceptional edition of the book fair, where the events and discussions will all shine a spotlight on the book's ability to ignite peoples' minds, appreciate cultural differences and bring them closer.

## Doordarshan completes 60 years of existence

**New Delhi :** The public broadcaster started its journey on this day in 1959 from Delhi. Today, over 90 percent of Indian population receive DD programmes.

Over the years, Doordarshan has grown into a network operating 34 satellite channels, besides providing free-to-air DTH service having 104 in its bookings.

Doordarshan has served people as a major source of information, education

and entertainment since years. Entertainment shows like Chitrahaar, Mahabharat, Dekh Bhai Dekh, Fauji, Malgudi Days, among others, captured the imagination of the Indian public in the late 80s and early 90s, and still remains etched in people's minds as pure entertainment that brought people together. In a tweet, Prasar Bharati CEO Shashi Shekhar Vempati said, it is a moment to recognise that

it is not that Doordarshan has gotten older, but it is getting newer for digital audiences.

He said, it is not only that Doordarshan has turned 60 but the history of television broadcasting in India now spans six decades - a milestone for all of TV industry in India. Director General, Doordarshan, Prasar Bharati, Supriya Sahu said, Doordarshan is in the DNA of India.

## India to conduct special training programme for Maldivian civil servants

**New Delhi :** India will conduct a two-week special training programme for Maldivian civil servants from tomorrow in Delhi and Mussoorie.

It is part of a bilateral MoU on Training and Capacity Building Programme between the National Centre for Good Governance (NCGG) and the Maldives Civil Service Commission (CSC). A 32-member delegation

from the Maldives reached the NCGG campus in Mussoorie.

Senior policy makers, including Director Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, would address participants in the training programme.

Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi, during his visit to the Maldives in June, had emphasised India's Neighbourhood

First policy. He assured India's full support to the Maldives in realising its aspirations for broad based socio-economic development and strengthening of democratic and independent institutions.

One of the MoUs envisages capacity building activities for 1,000 civil servants of the Maldives at the National Centre for Good Governance over the next five years.

1. The candidate should satisfy the following conditions: -

(a) Age : Age should be between 18 and 40 years as on closing date of receipt of applications by this office. The maximum age shall be relaxable by 5 years for ST category Candidates.

(b) Educational qualifications: Should have passed tenth (Xth) Standard. No weightage will be given for any qualification higher than SSLC or equivalent examination. However this does not bar the candidates with higher qualification from applying for the post.

(b)(i) Compulsory knowledge of Language

The candidate should have studied the local language at least up to 10<sup>th</sup> standard (as compulsory or elective subject) as declared by the state government as per constitutional provisions relating to the 8<sup>th</sup> schedule of constitution of India.

(d) Computer Knowledge: Basic computer training certificate for at least 60 days from a recognized Computer Training Institute. The Certificates from Central Government/ State Government/ University/ Boards etc., will also be acceptable for this purpose. This requirement of basic computer knowledge certificate shall be relaxable in cases where a candidate has studied computer as a subject in Class X or Class XII or higher educational qualification provided the candidate submits a certificate of Class X or Class XII or higher educational qualification in which he/ she has studied computer as a subject.
