PM Modi announces special economic package worth Rs 20 lakh crore to kick-start economy

New Delhi : Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced a special economic package worth 20 lakh crore rupees for an 'Atma-Nirbhar Bharat' or self-reliant India, saying that self reliance is the only way to ensure that 21st Century belongs to India. Addressing the nation the Prime Minister noted that this package, together with earlier announcements by the government during COVID crisis and decisions taken by RBI, is to the tune of 20 lakh crore rupees. This is equivalent to almost 10 percent of India's GDP.

The Prime Minister observed that the package will also focus on land, labour, liquidity and laws. It will cater to various sections including cottage industry, MSMEs, labourers, middle class, industries, among others. The Prime Minister said several bold reforms are needed to make the country self-reliant, so that the impact of crisis such as COVID, can be negated in future. These reforms include supply chain reforms for agriculture, rational tax system, simple and clear laws, capable human

COVID-19 recovery rate reaches to 38.29 percent in India

New Delhi : Health and Family Welfare Ministry said that a total 36 thousand 823 patients have been cured of corona virus and the recovery rate has reached 38.29 percent in the country.

During the last twenty four hours, 2 thousand 715 patients have recovered and 5 thousand 242 fresh cases of Covid-19 have been reported taking the total number of cases to 96169. A total of 157 deaths have been registered in last 24 hours taking the nationwide toll to 3029.

A Success Story -Vegetables Large Scale Production at Agatti

Agatti : With the dedicated efforts of the Field staff, technical staff and labourers in Agricultural Demonstration unit under the dynamic supervision of Mr. Asif. V, Agricultural Officer and unit in charge, Agatti has produced large number of vegetables such as Brinjal, amaranth, little gourd, bottle gourd, snake gourd, ash gourd, papaya, plantain, Drumstick, cucumber, pumpkin, curry leaves etc, also made available to public through the specially set up vegetable outlet in connection with commencement of the Holi Ramadan 2020. Keeping the social distancing and adhering other orders/instructions during time of Lockdown (Covid 19), the team works has been

successful to achieve the target, said Mr. Asif.

When asked about the sales in the outlet, he revealed that Tuesday is the sales day. Weekly 300 to 350 veg kit. Approximately 2.5kg per kit with a minimum of 5 vegetable items, according to the season and availability are arranged for public sale on week day, he said. Each kit costs Rs. 30/- only.

The soils in our Islands are very poor in organic content and not enough fertile and suitable for the cultivation of vegetables and fruits except coconut tree. Due to the sandy soil condition again is making the nutrient leaching and less water holding capacity. We need to take much more

efforts for overcome these hurdles. More over our islands are going to be declared as an organic territory. All the chemical fertilizer, pesticides, fungicides etc. are banned so that we could adopt only organic methods for the improvement of soil conditions and plant health. Our products are purely organic, safe to use and much valuable for our health. However, we should promote vegetable cultivation in our home, considering health hazards of the imported items from mainland which are completely contaminated with chemicals, he said. Not only that but also, we can save revenue loss due to the transportation cost.

Meanwhile Mr. O. P. Mishra, Secretary, (Agriculture) visited this

farm on 3rd March 2020.

After inspection, he appreciated the efforts being made by this unit to improve the vegetable production. Shri B. Hassan, Hon'ble President cum Chief Counsellor also paid a visit to this farm on his maiden visit to Agatti one year ago. He also expressed his satisfaction towards the extraordinary efforts of staff and labourers for producing organic vegetables in a large scale at Agatti.

The Dept. of Agriculture is planning suitable new projects to promote large scale production at possible extend with the use of maximum available area under homestead, terrace area, said Mr. Asif. He also revealed that for these annual projects are submitted and already

approved. It includes high quality seedlings production unit, agro clinic, large-scale compost production units, cluster and group formation, technical and monitoring teams etc.

The progressive Agricultural farmers should come forward to produce more so that we can achieve self-sufficiency in agricultural sector and avoid the import of the chemically treated vegetables from mainland with an aim to protect our health and the health of future generations. also, to protect our fragile island ecosystem with the use of natural organic inputs for the cultivation. As an initiation Agri dept is maintaining demonstration plots to encourage people also to provide possible extend to ensure organic vegetable and fruits on subsidized rate, it's a proud to the department that we could sell more than 1500 vegetable kits during this lockdown period, as a small contributions to the society at the time of scarcity facing due to the

shortage of cargo movement from mainland, said Mr. Asif.

Almost all the veg. crops can be cultivated in the geographical conditions prevailing in our islands, he said. Initiatives like on - farm trials (Integrated Crop Management) are being organized by the department for the adaptability of new crops. The recently conducted trial revealed that Chinese potato (koorka), and turmeric are also performed well in our soil. We can grow chilly, cabbage, tomato, Okra, for home use. It is always better to grow in suitable containers or in grow bags filled with a mixture of different organic manures, wood ash, coir pith or husk pieces and soil to fulfil conditions and to avoid root competition with the coconut tree and wild trees in the farm. Fruits trees like sapota, guava, west Indian cherry, papaya, Ber etc. are well adapted for homestead cultivation, said Mr. Asif in an interview.

resource and a strong financial system. These reforms will promote business, attract investment, and further strengthen Make in India.

The Prime Minister said that India bears a responsibility, recalling the Shastras, he highlighted the importance of self reliance. Mr Modi remarked that self-reliance will prepare the country for tough competition in global supply chain, and it is important that the country wins this competition. He said the COVID crisis has taught the importance of local manufacturing, local market and local supply chains. India's demands during the crisis were met 'locally'. He said it is time now to be vocal about local products and help these local products become global.

The Prime Minister said India has resources and talent, and it will make best products, improve quality and supply chain. He pointed out that India did not

produce any PPE before COVID-19 crisis and manufactured very few N-95 masks but now the nation is producing two lakh PPEs and 2 lakh N 95 masks. He said that India has converted a disaster into an opportunity. The world is now looking towards humanity centric globalisation. In this respect, the Prime Minister expressed confidence that India could lead the way.

He praised India's ancient culture saying that the wisdom of age old principles such as Vasudaiva Kutumbakam and harmony with nature ensure that world progress is central to India's conception of progress. Mr Modi clarified that when India talks about self-reliance, it is different from being self centred. He said that India considers the world as one family, and progress in India has always contributed to progress in the whole world. He also said India's initiatives such

as the International Solar Alliance were a gift to the world. Our centuries old conception of self reliance has always followed the path of global progress.

The Prime Minister expressed confidence in India's capabilities and manpower. He said that India will build new supply chains, create better products and lead the global recovery. Mr Modi said India's self-reliance will be based on five pillars - economy, infrastructure, technology driven system, vibrant demography and demand. The Prime Minister also said that Coronavirus is going to be a part of people's lives for a long time, but lives cannot simply revolve around it. He said Lockdown-4 will be different and have new rules. He added that new rules will be framed on the basis of recommendations received from states, and the people will be informed about it.
