Lakshadweep Times spoke to Member of Parliament, Lakshadweep Shri. P.P. Mohammed Faizal on the issues relating to preparedness in Lakshadweep during COVID -19 pandemic and his efforts along with UT Administration to keep Lakshadweep COVID free

Q. You have been very actively fighting the COVID-19 pandemic in Lakshadweep along with UT Administration, what was your initial response to the threat in March 2020?

A. India's first case of COVID-19 was confirmed on 30th January 2020 in Thrissur and there was a steady increase of number of patients in India as well as nearby states. In such a situation the need of the hour was making all sections of the society in a state of preparedness and also to alert the Lakshadweep Administration regarding the need to coordinate, communicate and to implement things on priority. Thus, on 19th March 2020, knowing well the situation after the flood in Kerala and panic purchases, the importance of procuring and stocking of essential

commodities were mooted and I took up the matter with Hon'ble Administrator. The U T Administration took action immediately and on the same day a circular was issued which enabled to procure sufficient essentials and keep a buffer stock for days to come.

I must thank Hon'ble Administrator and compliment his dedicated team of officers who despite the emergent

crisis made sure that the supplies of both food commodities and other essential items were smooth and seamless throughout the lockdown. The Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Cooperation, LCMF deserves special mention and appreciation for maintaining the continuous supply at all islands through the lockdown period and their efforts ensured that the Holy Ramzan month and

Eid was celebrated with full spirit by all.

Q. What were the steps taken in Lakshadweep after announcement of lock down to prevent spread of COVID-19?

A. Knowing well that our natural weakness of geographic isolation is the best tool in our hands to protect our people from this pandemic, a request was made to Hon'ble Administrator by me to close down the entry gate by stopping the inflow of both international and domestic tourists as well as to stop issue of all permits. Accordingly action was immediately taken to stop tourists coming to our Islands. Then my efforts were to bring back our students who were studying in different parts of mainland and in different states, as well as, people who are also in mainland and

Govt to transfer Rs. 500 to women account holders of Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana

New Delhi : Government will start sending the amount of 500 rupees to the women account holders of Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) for the month of June from today. The amount is the third installment under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package. The Department of Financial Services said, beneficiaries can withdraw the amount on any day after 10th June. The Department of Financial Services said, the amount will be sent as per time table based on the last digit of the beneficiary's account number. Ten thousand twenty nine crore rupees were credited to 20.05 crore women Jan Dhan account holders as the first installment. The number of women PMJDY account holders whose accounts have been debited by customer induced transactions under 1st instalment is 8.72 crore. Ten thousand three hundred fifteen crore rupees were credited to 20.62 crore women Jan Dhan account holders with second installment. The number of women PMJDY account holders whose accounts have been debited by customer induced transactions under 2nd instalment is 9.7 crore. As part of the 1.70 lakh crore rupees Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package, the Government announced free food grains and cash payment to women and poor senior citizens and farmers.

Health Ministry issues SOPs

New Delhi : The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has issued Standard Operating Procedures, SOPs for religious places, hotels, restaurants, shopping malls, hospitality services and workplaces. The objective of these SOPs is to minimize all possible physical contacts and maintain social distancing while adhering to preventive and safety measures against COVID-19. Recently, the Ministry of Home Affairs has issued the new guidelines for phased re-opening of areas

abroad. In such a pandemic situation knowing that we need a robust contingency plan, need to coordinate and also need to communicate with different sections of society. The idea was to provide information on risk, severity and progression of the pandemic and thus to enable me as well as the administration to make effective interventions. Thus we could manage to bring back around 3000 students and nearly 1000 of our people from mainland, which could not have been possible without the intervention and efforts of Hon'ble Administrator.

Q. Ministry of Health was issuing guidelines regarding the Protocol to be followed to fight corona. What preventive measures you took in Lakshadweep?

A. It was important to put forward concrete suggestions and plans to our health department about the risk and potential consequences of this type of a pandemic and the need for me to work in close coordination with the administration. A request was made to quarantine all those returned from mainland and the administration acted swiftly by imposing prohibitory order to stop further unnecessary movement of people. I could also convince the administration the need for additional doctors, nurses and paramedical staff to tackle any eventuality for which positive steps were taken by the administration. The need for essential COVID-19 testing equipments and the necessity to equip our hospitals with required medicines and also the need for a close coordination with our nearby state of Kerala was also emphasized. To

outside the containment zones after the strict lockdown imposed throughout the country on 24th March. In phase-one of the unlock period, the government has permitted opening of religious places, hotels, restaurants, shopping malls and other hospitality services for the public from 8th June. All the hotels, shopping malls, restaurants, religious places and other hospitality services in the containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside the containment zones will be

overcome any contingency I had a detailed discussion with the Hon'ble Home Minister on 3rd April and he was kind enough to give me all assurances like making available the services of specialist doctors from navy, making available services of Naval Helicopter for evacuating patients, converting cabins of our passenger ships with ventilators and also to provide all the required COVID-19 testing equipments on war footing if the situation so warrants. I thank Hon'ble Home Minister for all the support accorded to the people of Lakshadweep in the hour of crisis.

Q. To avert economic hardship faced by the poor and needy in Lakshadweep what was your plan of action?

A. When a nationwide lockdown was ordered on 24th of March by the GOI for 21 days, and, knowing well the hardships going to be experienced by the lower segments of people, labourers, daily wage earners and the devastating effect that is going to have in their family I made an appeal to Hon'ble Administrator to compensate the wage loss from the funds that was available in the labour welfare fund. I also released Rs.30 lakhs from MPLAD and I also took the initiative to collect and contribute Rs.2 lakhs from my party cadres. I could also convince Hon'ble Administrator the need for free supply of food grains to all ration card holders also requested Hon'ble Administrator not to disengage labourers and contract staffs during this time of wage loss and financial burden, which was implemented without any hesitation.

Q. Please share with our readers besides the steps mentioned above what other initiatives

allowed to open as per the guidelines issued by the government. All the hotels, restaurants, shopping malls, religious places, workplaces and other hospitality services are advised to have the arrangement of sanitizer dispenser and thermal screening at the entrance. Only asymptomatic persons shall be allowed in the premises. Spitting will be strictly prohibited. In the restaurants, takeaways are encouraged instead of dine-in and food delivery personnel will leave the packet at customer's door. The Health Ministry has advised the public to maintain physical distancing of at least six feet and the use of face masks. It has also been advised to use the Aarogya Setu App.

you took to mitigate the problems which people of Lakshadweep faced during the lockdown ?

A. To mention few other important steps I took up were the problems of those people who were stranded at Ernakulam, Kozhikode with the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Kerala and to make sure that they are also taken care by the state government which was immediately done by Hon'ble Chief Minister. Now efforts were to bring those people who were stranded in various parts of Kerala, Mangalore and other states to Islands and also to send back those people who got stranded in our islands from mainland. New Delhi : World Environment Day is being Celebrated across the globe today. It is the biggest annual event in the world run by the United Nations to mark the environmental awareness among the people. It's main aim is to raise awareness to protect nature and look at various environmental issues that are growing day by day. World Environment Day 2020 focuses on Biodiversity and will be hosted in Colombia in partnership with Germany. In India, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change will be holding virtual celebrations of World Environment Day on this year's theme with focus on Nagar Van, Urban Forests. Union Environ-

ment Minister Mr Prakash Javadekar will address the gathering on this occasion. Prime Minister Mr Narendra Modi in his latest Mann Ki Baat on last Sunday said that every Indian should pledge to create some difference to bring about positive change for the environment.

India though having less land mass and more human and cattle population has nearly 8 percent of biodiversity. The country is endowed with rich biodiversity having several species of animals and plants and hosts 4 of the 35 global biodiversity hotspots containing several endemic species. Biodiversity conservation has traditionally been considered confined to remote forest areas but



with increasing urbanization a need has arisen to safeguard and save biodiversity in urban areas also. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change relaunched a scheme for creating urban forest in 200 corporations and cities because all these cities have gardens but not forest. The urban forest will help in creating and enhancing the lung capacities of these cities.

Moreover all those people stranded in different islands were also taken back to their respective islands. The problem faced by those patients who were undergoing continuous treatment at mainland under specialist doctors were also taken up and wherever required medicines were made available by the

administration in all islands for the first time in our history of our Islands by my efforts and immediate steps taken by Hon'ble Administrator and line departments to make those medicines available in all islands.

Q. What would be your advice to people of Lakshadweep for coming days?

A. I would like to have a word of caution for my people that the fight against COVID-19 is only just begun. The worst is yet to come and the threat is more severe now than before. The corona virus cannot reach our territory on its own. We are the descendents of a generation which managed to live totally cut off from mainland every

year for almost 6 to 7 months. So my advice and request to all is that so far we are free from this pandemic so please, I repeat the word please, avoid all avoidable journeys to mainland and secure our borders from this pandemic and help the administration to secure our lives and also the lives of our near and dear ones. To conclude I request everyone to stay safe and stay positive, Together we all will come over this crisis and defeat corona virus. I once again thank Hon'ble Administrator, entire UT Administration and every resident of Lakshadweep who with their efforts have ensured that Lakshadweep remains the only Corona Virus free place in the country.

Re Structured SSLC and Plus Two Exams conducted with extensive arrangements

Kavaratti: Kerala State Education Board examinations for SSLC, plus one and plus two classes held on 26th to 31st May, which was earlier postponed due to COVID-19. The first session of Vocational Higher Secondary examinations was held

on Tuesday morning and the 10th standard examinations began in the afternoon. Over nine lakhs students of SSLC, plus one and plus two classes attended the State Board exams scheduled from 26th to 31st of May.

Extensive arrangements including thermal screening of students, disinfection of premises, strict social distancing, compulsory mask and sanitizer's usages are being done at all centres.

In Lakshadweep 841 students for SSLC examination and in plus one plus two categories 1144 and 1365 students attended in 9 centres arranged at various islands. In addition to that 268 students attended their examination those who are not able to reach their original centres due to COVID-19.

In Capital Island 96 Students attended for SSLC examination and 169 for plus one and 154 for plus two classes.

The examination began with great vigilance to close the loopholes of the COVID disease. The medical team of Indira Gandhi Hospital conducted thermal scanning of the students. Before entering the class room the students were washed their hands with sanitiser and provided mask as a safety measures. They maintained social distancing and seating arrangements made in 22 rooms at Government Senior Secondary School.

The mask and gloves also provided to the invigilation teachers and other staffs who associated with the conduct of examinations.
