He had said, poor and needy persons will not go hungry in the country and free ration during the rainy and forthcoming festival seasons during the time of current Covid-19 pandemic will be provided to them.

Written competitive examination will test the knowledge of the candidates in Science, Mathematics, Social Science (History, Geography, Economy and Politics), and knowledge of the candidates about the History and Geography of Lakshadweep and general awareness of the candidate on current issues of national and international importance. This shall consist of 100 multiple choice objective type questions carrying one mark each which will have to be answered in 120 minutes (2hrs) duration. The candidate has to secure a minimum of 40% marks in the written examination and meet medical standards to qualify for selection. The level of questions will be 10+2 (Plus two) standard and questions will be in English, Hindi and Malayalam languages. In case sufficient number of candidates not available to fill up the vacancies reserved for departmental candidate as stated above, the department reserve the right to relax up to 5% marks i.e. from 40% to 35% to fill the reserved vacancies.

### ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED

- Schools, colleges, educational & coaching institutions** to remain closed till 31 July, 2020
- International air travel of passengers**, except as permitted by Home Ministry
- Metro Rail**
- Cinema halls, gymnasiums, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars, auditoriums, assembly halls & similar places**
- Social/ political/ sports/ entertainment/ academic/ cultural/ religious functions & other large congregations**

### ACTIVITIES PERMITTED

\*Outside Containment Zones

- Training institutions of Central & State Govts to function from 15 July, 2020**; SOP to be issued by Deptt. of Personnel & Training
- Domestic flights & passenger trains** to be expanded in a calibrated manner
- Online/distance learning** continue to be encouraged
- No restriction on inter-State & intra-State movement of persons & goods**. No separate approval/ e-permit required for such movements

### NIGHT CURFEW

- Movement of individuals to remain strictly prohibited** between 10 pm to 5 am except for essential activities
- Essential activities allowed include** operation of industrial units, movement of persons & goods on National & State Highways, loading & unloading of cargo and travel of persons after disembarking from buses, trains and airplanes
- Local authorities to issue orders such as **Section 144 of CrPC and ensure strict compliance**

### LOCKDOWN LIMITED TO CONTAINMENT ZONES (2/2)

- Activities to be monitored by the State/UTs authorities & the guidelines for containment measures** to be implemented
- States/UTs to identify Buffer Zones outside containment zones**, where new cases are likely to occur
- States/ UTs, may prohibit certain activities outside the Containment zones**, or impose such restrictions as deemed necessary

### MOVEMENT OF PERSONS ALLOWED AS PER SOPs

- Movement by **passenger trains and Shramik special trains**
- Domestic passenger** air travel

- Evacuation of **foreign nationals**
- Sign-on and Sign-off of **Indian seafarers**

### STRICT ENFORCEMENT OF GUIDELINES

- States/UTs shall not dilute the guidelines** issued under the Disaster Management Act, 2005, in any manner
- All the District Magistrates shall strictly enforce** the Unlock 2.0 measures
- Any person violating the Unlock 2.0 measures liable to be proceeded against as per provisions of **Section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable**

### NATIONAL DIRECTIVES FOR COVID-19 MANAGEMENT (1/2)

- Wearing of face cover** is compulsory in public places, in workplaces, and during transport
- Individuals must maintain a **minimum distance of 6 feet (2 gaz ki doori)** in public places
- Shops to ensure physical distancing** among customers

### NATIONAL DIRECTIVES FOR COVID-19 MANAGEMENT (2/2)

- Large public gatherings/congregations** continue to remain prohibited
- Marriage related gatherings** : Number of guests not to exceed 50
- Funeral/ last rites related gatherings** : Number of persons not to exceed 20
- Spitting in public places punishable with fine**, as may be prescribed by State/UT local authority in accordance with its laws, rules or regulations
- Consumption of liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco etc.** prohibited in public places

### USE OF AAROGYA SETU APP

- District authorities **may advise individuals to install Aarogya Setu** & regularly update their health status on the app

### NATIONAL DIRECTIVES FOR WORKPLACES

- Work from home (WFH)** should be followed as far as possible
- Staggering of work/ business hours** to be followed in offices, work places, shops, markets and industrial establishments
- Thermal scanning, hand wash & sanitizer** at all entry & exit points & common areas
- Frequent sanitization** of the entire workplace, common facilities and all points e.g. door handles etc. to be ensured
- All persons in charge of workplaces **to ensure adequate distance between workers**, adequate gaps between shifts, staggering lunch breaks, etc.

### LOCKDOWN LIMITED TO CONTAINMENT ZONES (1/2)

- Lockdown continues to remain in force in the Containment Zones** till 31 July, 2020
- Containment Zones to be demarcated & notified** on websites by District authorities
- No movement of people in or out of these zones**, except for medical emergencies & for maintaining supply of essential goods & services
- Intensive contact tracing, house-to-house surveillance & other clinical interventions** as required to be conducted
