Sub: Recruitment of Marine Wildlife Protection Watcher in the Department of Environment & Forest- Schedule for Physical Endurance Test and Walk-in Interview- Reg;

Ref: Employment notice F.No. 1/2/2020-E&F dated 03.07.2020.

The Department of Environment & Forest is in the process of recruitment for the post of Temporary Lakshadweep Marine Wildlife Protection Force (LMWPF) Watchers and has published the final checklist (Island wise) of candidates on 02.09.2020. Due to ongoing COVID-19 protocol, restrictions and limitations of the transportation arrangement for the large number of Candidates to Kavaratti Island, the department has now decided to conduct the recruitment process for Marine Wildlife Protection Force Watchers at their respective 9 Islands (except Birta) simultaneously. The recruitment process for the candidates applied from Birta Island will be combined with Chetalt Island. The tentative recruitment process for the post of Marine Wildlife Protection Watchers as follows:

Date	Description of process	Venue
25 th September, 2020	Physical Measurement Test	Venue for all these recruitment process will be published by the concerned Island Range Office of the Department of Environment & Forest. The same will be published in the notice board of DC/SDO and in the Range Office of the Department of Environment & Forest.
26 th September, 2020	Physical Endurance Test – comfortably maintain themselves in sea water by completing a 10-minute float without using any swim/floating aids	
26 th September, 2020	Physical Endurance Test – 200 meters of swimming in the sea to be completed within 15 minutes	
27 th September, 2020	Physical Endurance Test – 25 km. walk to be completed within 4 hours	
28 th September, 2020 & 29 th September, 2020	Personality Test: Personal Interview	

The candidates of Birta can be avail the Ship MV Kavaratti on 26.09.2020 from Birta to Chetlet for attending in the recruitment process. All the candidates may also take a note that there will not be any individual communication will be made for the any of these tests. Further all the candidates are requested to keep them updated with the Lakshadweep website and notice boards of the Range Office/ DCs/ SDOs of the concerned Islands.
