

Further all the select listed candidates are directed to report before the Officer in Charge of their respective Forest Range within 3 days from the date of issue of this order. And subsequently directed to report at the Department of Environment & Forest, Headquarters, Kavaratti with all the original documents by the next available conveyance for the verification. Further confirmation of the contractual engagement will be subjected to the following conditions.

1. All the original documents will be verified by the duly constituted committee, for which candidate should carry Original documents with him.
2. If any candidate fails to produce required original certificates, then he will be disqualified and waitlisted candidate will be considered for engagement.
3. The candidate shall sign the contract agreement with the Department.
4. The candidates are liable to pay the prescribed fine if they leave the Department within 6 months after the completion of training.
5. The candidate shall produce Medical fitness certificate from the Government Hospital.
6. The candidate shall wear the prescribed uniform.
7. The candidate shall undergo Prescribed training at Kavaratti
