

**INTEGRATED CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES SCHEME
DADRA AND NAGAR HAVELI.**

In the U.T. of DNH ICDS Scheme was launched on 2nd October, 1978. Benefits under the department are provided through Anganwadi Centres. One Anganwadi Centre is set-up covering population between 300 to 800 and 1-Mini Anganwadi Centre is set-up covering population between 150 to 300.

In UT of DNH, 2-ICDS Project covering 219-Anganwadi Centres and 49 Mini-Anganwadi Centres are operational detailed as below:

Target Group:- Children between age group of 0-6 years & Pregnant Mother/ Nursing Mothers

Following package of services is provided to the beneficiaries through Anganwadi Centres.

BENEFITS:

1. Supplementary Nutrition Programme: Beneficiaries are provided supplementary nutrition as per norms fixed by the Ministry (detailed below) for 300 days in a year:

2. Pre-school Education :

Children between 3-6 years are enrolled for pre primary education.

SABLA SCHEME (Scheme for Adolescent Girls)

OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHEME

The objectives of the scheme are:

- (i) Enable self development and empowerment of Adolescent Girls
- (ii) Improve their nutrition and health status.
- (iii) Spread awareness among them about health, hygiene, nutrition, Adolescent reproductive and sexual health (ARSH) and family and child care;
- (iv) Upgrade their home-based skills, life skills and vocational skills.
- (v) Mainstream out-of-school Adolescent Girls into formal/non formal-education and
- (vi) Inform and guide them about existing public services, such as PHC, CHC, Post Office, Bank, Police Station etc.

TARGET GROUP

The scheme aims at covering Adolescent Girls. in the age group of 11 to 18 years. The target group is sub divided in two categories viz 11-14 and 14-18 year.

There are two components under the scheme:

Non-nutritional-Target group adolescent girls between 11-18 years.

Nutritional:- Target group 11-14 years only out of going school

14-18:- All girls, regardless of whether they are out of school or school going.

Beneficiaries are provided supplementary nutrition for 300 days in a year @ Rs. 5/- per day meeting the nutritional norms as per Pregnant Mother/Nursing Mothers

INDIRA GANDHI MATRITVA SAHYOG YOJANA (IGMSY) SCHEME

Under the scheme incentives of Rs. 4000/- is provided to Pregnant/Lactating Mother. Each PM/LM would receive total cash incentives of Rs. 4000/- between 2nd Trimester till the child attains the age of 6 months. After fulfillment of certain conditions i.e. registration of pregnancy till the completion of all vaccination. Detailed as below
