C I R C U L A R

In the light of ensuing COVID-19, the Ministry of Home Affairs vide Orders dtd. 30/09/2020 and 27/10/2020, referred in preamble (i) and (iii) above, have permitted the marriage and marriage related activities as well as funeral/last rites and funeral/last rites related activities outside the Containment Zone subject to certain conditions.

The U.T. Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu vide Order dtd. 15/10/2020, referred in preamble (ii) above, has issued guidelines related to the marriage & marriage related activities as well as funeral/last rites & funeral/last rites related activities outside the Containment Zone.


Therefore, in view of above the marriage & marriage related activities as well as funeral/last rites & funeral/last rites related activities outside the Containment Zone shall be permitted subject to the following conditions.

1. In closed spaces, a maximum of 50% of the Hall Capacity will be allowed, with a ceiling of 200 persons. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision for thermal scanning and use of hand or sanitizer will be mandatory.
2. In open spaces, such gatherings are allowed keeping the size of the ground / space in view, however, subject to a maximum of 200 persons only and with strict observance of social distancing, mandatory wearing of face masks, provision for thermal scanning and hand wash or sanitizer.
3. Persons above 65 years of age, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women and children below the age of 10 years are advised to stay at home, except for essential and health purposes.
4. Adequate physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed outside the auditoriums, common areas and waiting areas at all times.
5. Use of face covers/masks shall be mandatory at all times.
6. Respiratory etiquettes shall be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing / sneezing with a tissue / handkerchief elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
7. Spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
8. Installation and use of Arogya Setu App shall be mandatory.
9. Entry & Exit Points:
 - (i) Thermal screening of visitors / staff is to be carried out at entry points. Only asymptomatic individuals shall be allowed to enter the premises.

- (ii) Provisions for hand sanitization should be made available at all entry points and in work areas.
 - (iii) Designated queue markers shall be made available for entry and exit of the invitees from the auditorium and the premises.
 - (iv) The Exit should be done in a staggered row-wise manner to avoid crowding.
10. Proper crowd management in the parking lots and outside the premises – duly following physical distancing norms shall be ensured.
 11. Efforts shall be made to avoid overcrowding in the common areas, lobbies and washrooms.
 12. Frequent sanitization of the entire premises, common facilities and all points which come into human contact e.g. handles, railings, etc. shall be ensured.
 13. Disinfection of the premises shall be taken up if any person is found COVID-19 positive.
 14. Temperature Settings of all air-conditioning devices should be in the range of 24-30° C with relative humidity between 40-70% and re-circulation of air to be avoided to the extent possible. Also, intake of fresh air should be as much as possible.
 15. The use of loudspeaker during the event shall be strictly from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and no specific permission in this regard shall be sought.

Intimation shall be mandatorily given to the Office of Resident Dy. Collector (Silvassa) / SDM, D&NH and Resident Dy. Collector (Khanvel) / SDM, D&NH, for only marriage & marriage related activities as well as funeral/last rites & funeral/last rites related activities outside the Containment Zone.

However, Prior Permission for processions and any other congregation for Social / Academic / Sports / Entertainment / Cultural / Religious / Political functions shall be mandatorily taken from the Office of Resident Dy. Collector (Silvassa) / SDM, D&NH and Resident Dy. Collector (Khanvel) / SDM, D&NH.
