

ORDER
(u/s 144 Cr.PC)

WHEREAS, for the infrastructural development of the District of Dadra & Nagar Haveli, the U.T. Administration of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu has undertaken many developmental projects such as Ring Roads, Flyovers, Sky Walks etc.;

AND WHEREAS, a similar project of flyover has been undertaken at Ring Road Junction 'G' at Piparia;

AND WHEREAS, due to the continuous flow of heavy vehicular traffic on the said flyover project at Piparia, Junction 'G' coming from Piparia Bridge, the same has become prone to road accidents, which could easily endanger the lives of the people using it;

THEREFORE, in view of above and in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Dr. Rakesh Minhas, District Magistrate, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, hereby order as under:

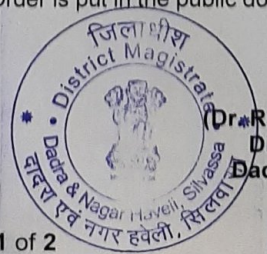
1. The use of the road from Piparia Bridge towards Silvassa and vice versa shall be strictly prohibited till further orders;
2. The vehicles coming from Piparia Bridge shall use the diversions provided for the respective Heavy Motor Vehicles and Light Motor Vehicles in order to get to their destinations in Silvassa;
3. The agency shall provide necessary signage for diversion of traffic;
4. The agency shall provide sufficient quantity of blinkers and reflectors for barricades and road closures;
5. The agency should provide height restriction barricade structure near Piparia Junction for the restriction of entry of vehicles to Silvassa town;
6. The agency should provide necessary access to the people whose residences fall within the stretch of road that has been closed;
7. The Superintendent of Police, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, shall deploy sufficient staff / marshals to control the entry / exit of traffic of the nearby residents at Piparia Junction.

Any person found in contravention of this order shall be punishable under Section 188 of Indian Penal Code.

In case of violation of above directions, violating vehicles will be impounded and shall be released on payment of prescribed penalty.

This order shall come into force immediately and shall remain in force for 30 days from the date of issuance.

As the order cannot be served individually, the Order is put in the public domain for information and necessary action.
