



ORDERS UNDER SECTION 144 OF CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Ukhrul, the 6th August, 2020

No. 7/88/2019-DM/UKL: In pursuance of the Home Department's order No. 9/6(1)/2020-H(Pt) dated 6th August, 2020, extending lockdown to check the spread of COVID-19 infection, it is thus, expedient to issue prohibitory orders to prevent public health crisis and law and order issue in the District;

Whereas, there is emergency and circumstances do not permit serving due notice upon the public, this order is passed Ex-Parte under Sub-Section 2 of Section 144, Cr.P.C., 1973, and is directed to the public in general.

Now, therefore, **I, Joseph Pauline Kamson, IAS**, District Magistrate, Ukhrul, Manipur in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Sub-Section 2 of Section 144, Cr.P.C., 1973, do hereby prohibit the movement of any person outside their respective residence **from 12:00 Noon to 8:00 AM with effect from 07-08-2020 till 15-08-2020 or until further orders in the whole of Ukhrul District. However, Market and shops selling essential commodities will remain opened from 8:00 am to 12:00 Noon on all days except Sunday.** Any person found in violation of the prohibitory order will be punished under Section 188 of IPC.

This prohibitory order shall not apply to government agencies involved in the enforcement of law and order and the maintenance of essential services.
