Public Service Guarantee Act 2010 is a bill passed by the state of Madhya Pradesh of India. According to this, the public servants will have to complete the work in the deadline and if they do not, then they will be fined between Rs 500 and Rs 5,000 depending on the accountability.

Citizens do not have to make rounds of the offices to create electrical, water connections, children's education in the school, birth, death, residence and marriage certificate. FIR Do not be mesmerized for the copy. Repair of ration cards and handpumps will not be delayed. From time to time all the work that will not be done at the time will be penalized for delaying those tasks. The delay will compensate the victim. This compensation can be from Rs. 250 to Rs. 5000.
