1. Introduction :

Osmanabad.gov.in/Osmanabad.nic.in is the official website of the Collector Office Osmanabad. The total website is designed by the National Informatics Center, Osmanabad (MS) & hosted by the NIC HQ, Delhi.

2. Process of data Upload on Website :

As the pervious observation of the data uploading process by NIC Osmanabad, it is observed that there is major gap between the user department & NIC understanding. In previous process NIC was supposed to predict lot of things (link: removable date, link name, information type ...etc). Due to not proper record maintained for web data uploading details.

To overcome this issue/problem, NIC Osmanabad designed simple **Website Uploading Form** in English & Marathi, which covers all basic information required to upload any information on the website. Along with that for updating the information on website proper information tracking process is maintained by keeping proper entries of the information update on the website.

The step by step procedure formed for uploading information is as following,

1. For uploading the information on the district website every government department has to submit the following form signed by the Head of Department, along with the information. This covers all basic information required to upload the content on the web site. Form is made available for downloading itself on the district web site for every department.

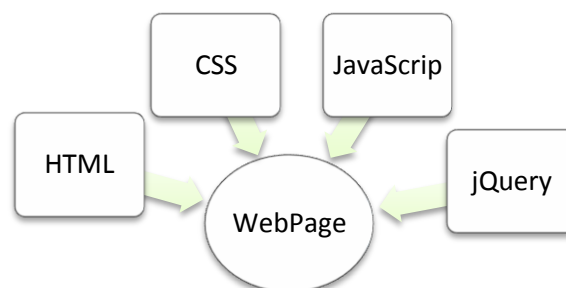
2. After receiving the form it is verified by the respective authority (DIO/DIA) & uploaded on the server.
3. After uploading the information on website, the concern department gets communication from NIC vide letter and the department also gets conveyed for ensuring the contents uploaded correctly.
4. Every day, information on the website is checked & accordingly as per the date written in the Website Upload Form. If information is expired then it will be removed from the website.

3. Information Correctness Certificate

As per the circular issued by the state government, information available or uploaded on website must be certified as a updated & correct by the respective department. So for the correctness of the information on website, every department has to submit the *Information Correctness Certificate* along with information. A procedure for submission of such certificate by the respective department also has been streamlined.

4. Technical Features :

Site is designed using the latest web technologies available. This is total static site build by using HTML & supporting technologies. Following is the list of the technologies used.



WebPage = HTML + CSS + JavaScript + jQuery

Main technical features of the site are as listed below.

➤ **Uniformity in Web Page Design:**

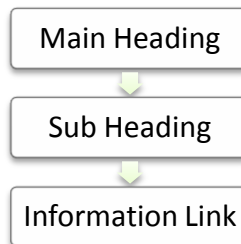
Over all sites maintain the uniformity of WebPages. Every page of website look like it belongs to the same site. Total uniformity is maintained by using the *CSS*.

(**Cascaded Style Sheet**) It keeps uniformity in background, font, colors, and size of text. On all pages of the website there is similarity in the font, colors & size of headings, titles, paragraphs.

Also CSS provides the facility of carrying out the required modification easy to modify the design of the overall site by making change in only one CSS file.

➤ **Organization in Web Design :**

Site organized in such way that user should be able to *find the information she/he needs within three clicks*. All information present is organized in the three levels structure



➤ **Browser compatibility :**

Website is designed in such way that it is compatible with most of the all browses. So site is compatible with IE6, IE7, IE8, Mozilla Firefox, Apple Safari, Opera, and Google Chrome.

➤ **Webdesign standards :**

Total site follows *W3C CCS3 Standards*. W3C (World Wide Web Consortium) is an international community work to develop Web standards. According to these standards it verifies the code and CSS used fulfills the technical standers. Osmanabad.nic.in does not have any error or warning for CSS3. You can check this by using the link provided at the bottom of home page of site.

➤ **Google Map Integrated :**

For the displaying the district Osmanabad map on sit *Google Map API* is used. It makes user easy to browse the locations in district.

➤ **NO Flash all in jQuery**

All Slide shows of images & test are designed using the jQuery. There is no use of flash in the website. The main benefited of this is the easy to modify & access speed. In flash if we need to add the extra image then we has to redesign the total flash. But in the jQuery it uses the total HTML code, so at any time we can add contain to that object.

➤ **Colors & Fonts :**

There the total uniformness in the color & font on the website. Every page uses the same structure for WebPages.

➤ **Sitemap - Powerful Navigation Aide :**

A site map represents structure of a website, textually as well as graphically, on a single page. Total structure of the Osmanabad.nic.in website can be understood from the Sitemap provided on the website. It makes user to easily identify the any contains on the site.

➤ **Website Monitoring (Google Web Analytics):**

For the enhancing the features, site is kept under the continuous monitoring using the *Google Analytics*. This gives various types of reports of the site uses.

5. Gov of India Website Standards

Website is designed as per the Government of India Website Standards.

1. Default (Landing) page of website is Marathi and all other pages are Marathi & English.
2. Website follows all W3C website standards like.. CSS, HTML validation. Also link is provided at bottom of website for the validation of standards.
3. As per the standards features like search, feedback, sitemap etc.. are provided in the site.
4. Correctness of information is maintained by following the proper procedure for the information upload & removal after the expiry.
5. Different policies (Hyperlinking Policy, Privacy Policy, Copyright Policy) regarding usage of website are mentioned.
