

Three Days Training Program on 'e-Uparjan Application' at District Sehore (M.P.)

On the request of M.P. State Civil Supply Corporation Madhya Pradesh, NIC Madhya Pradesh State Center, Bhopal conceptualized, designed and developed "e-Uparjan offline Application" – in consultation with department of food and civil supply, govt. of M.P. and under the guidance of Sh. A.N. Siddiqui, Technical Director NIC MPSC. The product is an effective, efficient and transparent system for monitoring the procurement center wise status of daily grain procurement in the state. An online module also developed to get consolidate reports on grain procurement.



Subsequently M.P. State Civil Supply Corporation Sehore and Jila Sahkari Kendriya Bank Sehore in association with NIC DIC Sehore organised three days training program from 26/2/2012 to 28/2/2012 on "e-Uparjan MIS" at District Jila Sahkari Kendriya Bank, Meeting Hall, Sehore.

Dr. Sanjay Goel, Collector and District Magistrate, Sehore chaired the workshop. In his inaugural address, the district Collector welcomed the gathering and emphasized an urgent need of this application to monitor and systematized the grain procurement on minimum support price. The District Collectors enlightened feature of application and review the implementation status of project in district.

District Sehore has 94 procurement centers. Three days training organized by NIC Sehore in 6 batches. The Additional Collector Sh.S.S. Baghel, Joint Collector Sh. Girish Sharma, all Sub Divisional Magistrate district Sehore, all Tehsildar Sehore, District Supply Officer Sehore, General Manager Jila Sahkari Kendriya Bank, General manager MP CSC Sehore, 95 Computer operator, 95 society managers and 25 runner attended the training program.

DIO NIC Sehore Sanjay Joshi imparted the training for maintenance of hardware, which will use at procurement center during procurement. He also explained the objective and scope of the e-Uparjan application. All the features of the "e-Uparjan Application" also explained to all participants.

The data input formats and procedure to capture daily procurement data were explained to the participants and hard copy of user manual also provided to all society manager / data entry operators.
