

Two Days Training Program on 'e-Uparjan Application' District Sehore (M.P.)

On the initiative of M.P. State Civil Supply Corporation Madhya Pradesh, NIC Madhya Pradesh State Center, Bhopal conceptualized, designed and developed "e-Uparjan offline Application" – in consultation with department of food and civil supply, govt. of M.P. and under the guidance of Sh. A.N. Siddiqui, Technical Director NIC MPSC. The product is an effective, efficient and transparent system for monitoring the procurement center wise status of daily wheat procurement in the state. An online module also developed to get consolidate reports on wheat procurement.

The district Sehore has 146 procurement centers and 53,000 farmers have been registered for wheat procurement season 2013. Subsequently M.P. State Civil Supply Corporation Sehore, Jila Sahkari Kendriya Bank Sehore in association with NIC DIC Sehore organised two days training program from 02/03/2013 to 03/03/2013 on "e-Uparjan MIS" at District Jila Sahkari Kendriya Bank, Meeting Hall, Sehore.



The training program organized in two batches. DIO NIC Sehore Sanjay Joshi imparted the training for maintenance of hardware, which will use at procurement center during procurement. He also explained the objective and scope of the e-Uparjan application. The salient features of the system like sending SMS to farmers, daily wheat procurement, printing of receipt, issue/receipt of bags, modification in farmer's details were explained with do's & don'ts. The web page developed and hosted by NIC Sehore on district website for assistance to data entry operator and runners during procurement process also demonstrated to the participants. The online module of e-Wheat Procurement 2013 also demonstrated.

Sh Sourabh Sahu, DIA NIC Sehore advised Data Entry Operators & Runners to take care of the Data entry, Data backup, hardware's and Software's maintenance. He clarified the doubts raised by the participants and gave necessary guidelines for data compilation etc. The details like name, mobile number etc of NIC Quick Response Team provided to the participants.

At the end the officers and participants appreciated the efforts of NIC for developing such a user-friendly application and making the entire planning process simple, transparent & effective.
