District Emergency Operation Centre, Kullu

In line with the national emergency communication plan and national disaster management information and communication system, emergency operation centers (EOCs) would be set-up at the district level. The EOCs would have fail-safe communication network with multiple levels of built-in redundancy having communication to ensure voice, data and video transfer. For last mile connectivity and control of the operations at the disaster hit areas, availability of portable platforms will be catered for. Use of community radios, FMC channels, bulk SMS system and voice messaging system would be made for the last mile connectivity.

Keeping with the disasters a Control room is set up at the district headquarters Kullu in the complex of Deputy Commissioner Office, for day to day monitoring of incidences of disasters within the district along with search and rescue and relief operations in the wake of a disaster. It is established on 24x7 basis for operationalizing the contingency plan and for keeping a close liaison with the state headquarters, departments within districts, NGO's, and other agencies dealing with disaster management and relief.

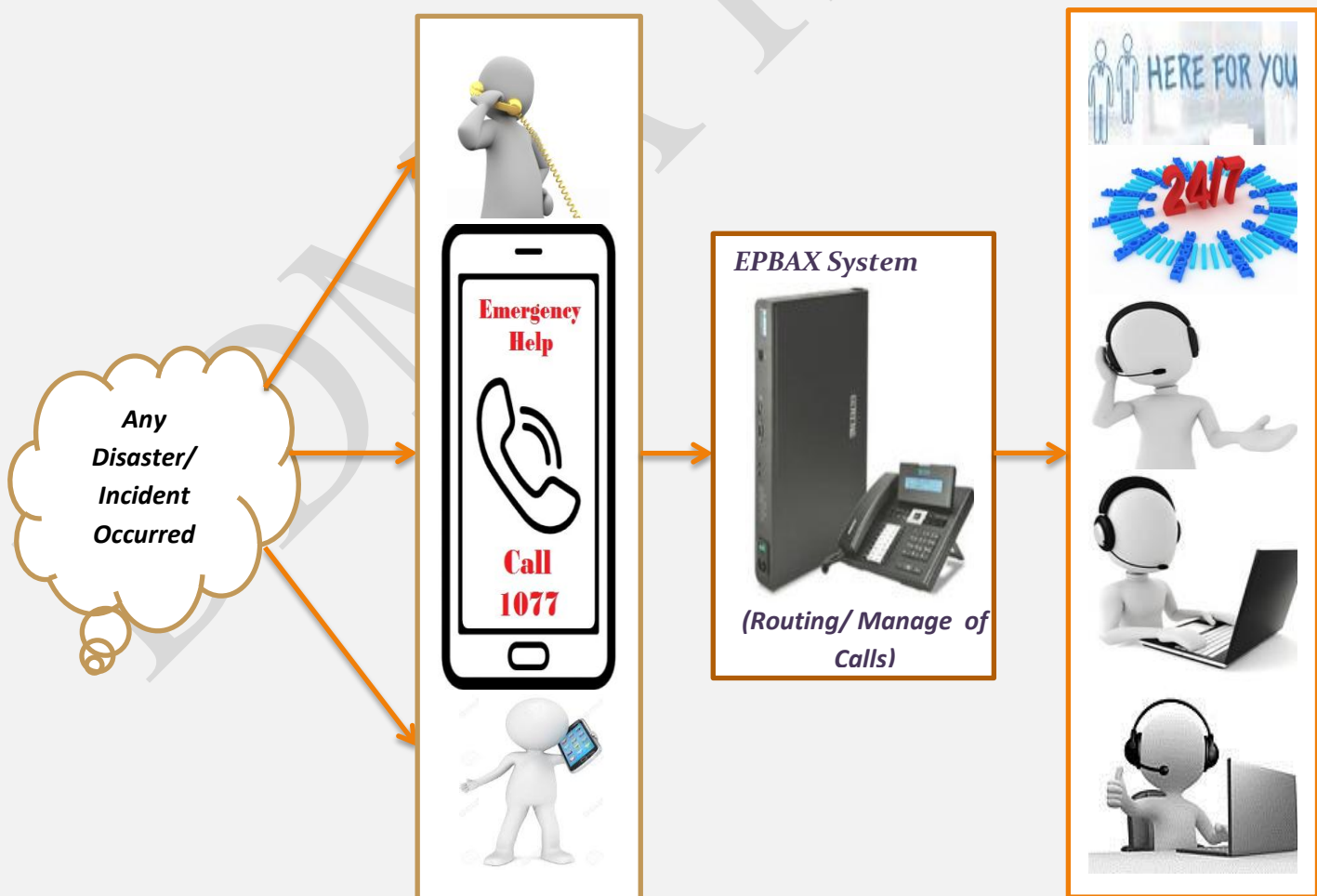
DEOC will assist the commissioner in performing the roles assigned to him by DDMA

like:

- ❖ Monitoring, coordinating and implementing the actions for disaster management
- ❖ Transmitting and receiving information about the development of the crisis on a continuous basis to State Relief Commissioner and appropriate agencies for immediate action
- ❖ Collection and submission of information related to implementation of relief measures to the State Relief Commissioner
- ❖ Ensure that all warning, communication systems and instruments are in working conditions

- ❖ Maintain a web-based inventory of all resources through the India Disaster Resource Network (IDRN)
- ❖ Provide information to the Relief Commissioner' Office of the disaster/ emergencies /accidents taking place in the district regularly and maintain a data base of disasters and losses caused by them
- ❖ Providing information at district level, local level and to disaster prone areas through appropriate media
- ❖ Maintain a data base of trained personnel and volunteers who could be contacted at any time
- ❖ Lease with on-site operation centre, State EOC and other emergency services.
