**ORDER U/s 144 Cr. PC.**

Whereas, in view of the present situation of COVID-19 in the State, the initial signs of surge in cases of COVID-19 as well as increased detection of the variant of concern 'Omicron' in different parts of the country, the Government of Himachal Pradesh, Revenue Department-Disaster Management Cell vide order No. Rev(DMC)(C)20-2/2022-COVID-19, dated 05/01/2022 has imposed some restrictions to contain the spread of variant of concern (VoC), 'Omicron' in the state.

And whereas, it has been directed that all the District Magistrates of concerned districts will ensure strict compliance of the orders ibid.

Now, therefore, keeping in view the present situation and in compliance to order No. Rev(DMC)(C)20-2/2022-COVID-19, dated 05/01/2022 issued by the Government of Himachal Pradesh, Revenue Department-Disaster Management Cell, I, **Ashutosh Garg, IAS, District Magistrate, Kullu** in exercise of the powers vested in me under **Section 144 of Cr.PC.** and Section 34 of Disaster Management Act 2005 do hereby order that:


1. "No Mask- No Service" policy will remain operational in the district.
2. There shall be **Night Curfew** in the district from **10PM to 5AM** daily.
3. In all indoor/ covered areas and open spaces including marriage palaces & banquet halls, for all social/ academic/ sports/ entertainment/ cultural/ political/ religious and other congregations are allowed with **50% of the capacity** subject to adherence of the COVID-19 safety protocols and COVID appropriate behaviour.
4. Hotels and restaurants shall remain open subject to strict adherence to COVID appropriate behaviour.
5. Cinema Halls/ Multiplex/ Sports Complex/ Stadiums/ Swimming Pools/ Gymnasiums **shall remain closed till further order.**
6. No **langar** shall be allowed in religious places/ places of worship.



**Penal Provisions:**

Any person violating these measures and not following COVID appropriate behaviour will be liable to be proceeded against in accordance with law and legal action will be taken under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act 2005.

This order will come into force with immediate effect in all parts of District Kullu and shall remain in force till further order.
