ORDER U/s 144 Cr. PC

Whereas, keeping in view the present situation of COVID-19 pandemic in the State, the sudden surge of cases in the district, as well as increased detection of 'omicron' variant in various parts of the country, the Government of Himachal Pradesh, Revenue department- Disaster Management Cell through its State Executive Committee (SEC) has issued guidelines for imposing certain restrictions in the State vide orders No. Rev(DMC) (C)20-2/2022- COVID-19 dated 05/01/2022 and Rev(DMC) (C)20-2/2022- COVID-19 dated 09/01/2022.

And whereas, in view of the prevailing conditions, it is important to impose certain restrictions to break the chain of transmission of the virus and check the current surge of Covid19 cases in the district.

Now therefore, in view of what has been stated above I, **Ashutosh Garg, IAS, District Magistrate, Kullu** in exercise of the powers vested in me under **Section 144 of Cr.PC.** and Section 34 of Disaster Management Act 2005 do hereby order the following restrictions/ measures that:

- There shall be strict night curfew in the district from 10PM to 5AM. However, this restriction shall not be applicable on vehicles/persons involved in provision of essential services/emergency services.
- All gatherings/congregations are permitted up to 50% of the capacity, subject to a maximum of 100 persons in indoor built up/covered areas (whichever is lower) and a maximum of 300 persons in open spaces. Strict observance of Covid appropriate behavior and safety protocol shall be followed in such gatherings. Further, it shall be compulsory for the concerned individual/organization to register the detail of the event in advance on <http://covid.hp.gov.in>

There shall be a total ban on Langar/Community kitchens/dhaams in all places in the district.

- All shops/markets/commercial establishments in the district shall only be open till 6:30PM in the evening. However, this restriction shall not be applicable to Chemist shops/pharmacies.
- All restaurants/pubs/eateries in the district shall operate at 50% occupancy.

Penal Provisions:

Any person violating these measures and not following COVID appropriate behaviour will be liable to be proceeded against in accordance with law and legal action will be



taken under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act 2005.


This order will come into force with immediate effect in all parts of District Kullu and shall remain in force till 06 AM on 24th January, 2022.
