ORDER

In exercise of the power conferred on me under Section 115 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988, I, **Ajit Roy, IAS, District Magistrate, North Goa** hereby grant permission to the Mayor/Chairman, Panjim Carnival Committee, Corporation of the City of Panaji for closure of D.B.B. Marg from Ribandar Causeway to Bاندodkar Football Ground, Campal on **13/02/2021** to hold Carnival Float Parade, 2021 from **13:00hrs onwards** till the completion of float parade or till 10:00pm, whichever is earlier, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The float Parade should be lined up and should start from Santa Monica Jetty or Divja Circle.**
2. The participating floats from Taleigao and Santa Cruz area shall be informed well in advance to report to starting point in time via NH-17 and not from the city roads.
- 3. Strong View Cutters of minimum 12 feet height** should be erected from Bاندodkar Statue till Divja Circle on the central medians and on both the Mandovi Bridges and Atal Setu, on either side parapets, to prevent motorists and public from viewing the parade by halting their vehicles on D. B. B. Marg and by standing on the other lane and also from the top of both the Mandovi Bridges, so as not to obstruct the free flow of vehicular traffic in the open lane of D. B. B. Marg and on both the Mandovi Bridges.

4. Entire float parade route should be **strongly barricaded** so as to prevent spectators from spilling over to the parade route.
5. Minimum one volunteer should accompany every float to maintain distance between the two floats and to ensure **no unnecessary gap** is left between the two floats.
6. The organizer shall culminate the floats at Bandothkar Football Gound, Campal, Panaji.
7. The organizer shall deploy minimum **100 Traffic Volunteers**. At least **50 Traffic Volunteers** should be deployed to ensure orderly parking of the vehicles in the city and **50 Traffic Volunteers** should be deployed to ensure No Parking along D. B. B. Marg.
8. The organizers should not obstruct the entrance of the nearby Residential buildings/houses.
9. The Traffic Police shall make necessary arrangement for the vehicular traffic.
10. The participants of the exhibition should maintain social distancing and shall wear face mask, face shield, hand gloves and carry bottle of sanitizer for frequent use and shall obey the notification/guidelines issued by Ministry of Health in view of COVID-19 pandemic
11. Permission from the other competent authorities should be obtained.
12. The organizers should ensure that the floats are lined up well inside the Ribandar Causeway closed for traffic, especially to facilitate the parking of floats. As any spill over outside on the Divja Circle will be a cause of concern.
13. **The organizers shall strictly comply with the SOP vide No.23/5/TIS/CITY/MAG/2013 dated 12/02/2021 issued by the District Magistrate North Goa.**
14. **If the organizers fail to adhere to above conditions and cause obstruction for smooth movement of traffic and consequent traffic jam, the NOC issued will be revoked immediately without giving any further notice.**
15. This permission is subject to cancellation/ revocation at any moment.
