

ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas, it has been made to appear to me that there is likelihood of causing tension, annoyance, obstruction or injury to person, danger to human life and property disturbance of public peace and tranquility in district Rohtak on call of Bharat Band against to take back new agriculture law by Bhartiya Kissan Union and other Organizations on 08.12.2020.

And whereas, it has been made to appear to me that the gathering of Five or more persons, carrying of weapon of offence like fire arms, swords, gandasa, lathis, barchas, kulahris, jalis, kanive and other weapons in the area of district Rohtak may cause obstruction in the maintenance of peace and tranquility in district Rohtak.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Captain Manoj Kumar, IAS, District Magistrate, Rohtak do hereby prohibit the gathering of five or more persons, the carrying of weapon of offence like fire arms, swords, gandasa, lathis, barchas, kulahris, jalis, knives and other weapons within area of District Rohtak.

This order shall not apply to the police personnel and other public servants on duty.

This order shall remain in force till strike is over.

In view of emergent situation or shortage of time, this order is passed ex-parte and is being addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated in the area of District Rohtak by beat of drum by announcement through the publicity van of Public Relation Department and by affixing of the copies of this order on the notice boards of the District Courts/Sub Division/Tehsil Courts/Police Stations

Any violation of this order is punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
