ORDER.

Whereas, Election Commission of India has announced the schedule for General Elections to Lok Sabha and Legislative Assembly Arunachal Pradesh 2019 vide Letter No. ECI/PN/23/2019 dated 10<sup>th</sup> Mar/2019.

And Whereas, in order to maintain law and order in the district effectively and to ensure peace and tranquility during the entire election period , it is felt expedient and necessary to impose restriction on all licensed arms holders and get all licensed arms deposited with the Officer-in-Charge of the Police Stations in the district.

Therefore , I Smti Mitali Namchoom , IAS, District Magistrate , Lower Dibang Valley District , Roing in exercise of the power conferred upon me U/S 17(3) (b) of the Arms Act, 1959 ( No. 54 of 1959) and the Arms Rules, 1962 read along with the Indian Arms Act, 1878 do hereby direct as per the provisions of Section 21(1) of the said act that all the licensees of the fire arms of this district shall mandatorily deposit their firearms to the respective police station and the same shall remain deposited till one week after counting is over i.e. till completion of the Election process.

Further, order is passed to the effect that respective Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station shall deposit the firearms of the licensees in the armoury of the Police Station under a proper acknowledgement to the licensee. They are also directed to serve the notice to all the licensed arms holder of the district immediately.

The licensed arms shall be deposited by the licensee within 7 (Seven) days of receipt of this order. Any violation of this order shall be dealt strictly under relevant provisions of law, and may even result in cancellation of the license.
