Sub: Provision of Rs. 500/- towards Assured Drop-Back Transport Services for Pregnant Women after Institutional Delivery & Sick Infants treated at Public Health Facilities.

Madam/Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am to inform that, Government in Health & Family Welfare Department, after careful consideration declared that in order to ensure free drop back transport services to pregnant women & sick infants, DBT (cash incentives) of Rs. 500/- will be given to the pregnant women after institutional delivery and sick infants treated at public health facilities for arranging suitable transport system on their own back to their Home instead of drop back services through 102 Ambulance Services (Janani Express) with effect from 01.09.2018. Funds for the purpose has been allocated under SAMMPurNA.

The guiding principles of the scheme are given below:

- All institutional delivery cases at public health facilities and sick infants (up to 1 year) admitted in critical care units like NRCs, NBSUs, SNCUs, NICUs / PICUs will be eligible for getting this incentive. However, all LAMA cases and pregnant women not stayed 48 hours after delivery will not be eligible to get the cash incentive.
- The incentive package will be transferred to beneficiary A/c through DBT within 48 hours of discharge from respective public health facility along with JSY package in case of pregnant women and sick infants, within 48 hours of discharge after treatment at respective public health facility.
- Drop Back services during pregnancy, delivery and post delivery for pregnant women and sick infants for treatment at public health facilities through 102 Services (Janani Express) shall be ceased with immediate effect.
- Funds available under SAMMPurNA shall be utilised for this purpose.
- Monthly Physical and financial progress should be submitted to SAMMPurNA cell and Mission Directorate as per the prescribed format attached at Annexure-A.
